## DECLARATION, UNDERTAKING AND AGREEMENT BY OWNER OR AGENT

1. I HEREBY DECLARE that the dog or dogs entered by me as above are REGISTERED in my name, with the Irish Kennel Club.
2. I HEREBY DECLARE that the dog or dogs entered by me as above are not vicious, and are bona-fide my property, and I enter them subject to the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club, and the Regulations of the Show which appear in the schedule and which I have read.
3. I HEREBY UNDERTAKE not to bring within the precincts of the show any dog or dogs, suffering from any infection or contagious disease or which has been exposed to any such disease during a period of six weeks prior to the show
4. IN CONSIDERATION of my entry being accepted, I hereby agree (1) to indemnify the I.K.C. Ltd. and /or its trustees, officials in respect of any damage or loss from whatsoever source arising, caused by, or to any dogs exhibited by me while in the precincts of the show and (2) that any decision given concerning me by the I.K.C. Ltd. or by any committee thereof in connection with any matter whatsoever arising through or at this show shall be communicated by the secretary of the I.K.C. Ltd. to all whom it may concern, and that any such decision together with a report of the proceedings in the matter may also be published together with my name, address and description.
5. I HEREBY UNDERTAKE to abide by the rules and regulations of the I.K.C. Ltd. and of its' show.
6. I UNDERTAKE to indemnify the promoters against any claims arising out of my participation as a competitor in the show.

## **RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW**

- 1) The promoting body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The promoting body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
- 2) Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners.
- 3) No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it at the show.
- 4) A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
- 5) Groups will be divided into 10 sections as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
- 6) Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their Best of Breed and Green Star Card.
- 7) In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3<sup>rd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> place, absentees **MUST** be marked.
- 8) Competition for Best in Show is confined to the winners of the 10 groups. Competition for the award of Reserve Best in Show will be confined to the winners of Groups and the 2nd winner in that Group from which came the winner of Best in Show.
- 9) If the Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

### **Please Note**

A puppy which has won a Green Star and Best of Breed and which is subsequently beaten in the Puppy Stakes may not compete in the Group, however the puppy does retain the Green Star
