SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **Jurisdiction:** The Show will be held under the Rules of The Irish Kennel Club Ltd., and a copy of the I. K. C. Rules and Regulations will be in the Secretary's Office on the day of the Show.
2. **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 36, Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6
3. **Venue-** The Show will be held in the **National Show Centre Cloghran, Co. Dublin**, on Saturday 14th. August 2010
4. **ENTRIES:** First Dog: €18.00 All additional entries €6.00, Brace, Veteran Stakes, Junior Handling Classes all €5.00 extra. All dogs entered in these stakes must be entered in their Breed Class.
5. **Fees of exhibits** arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
6. **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
7. **Judging:** Will commence at **9.30 am. sharp**. No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the Ring.
8. **Responsibility:** Exhibitors will please understand that while every precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of an exhibit, The All Terrier Association will not be responsible for any loss or damages sustained by an exhibitor through accident or otherwise.

All ENGLISH/FOREIGN EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

Cheques drawn in Euro on English Banks will not be accepted as they cannot be cleared without incurring Bank Charges. Only Euro Cheques drawn on Irish Banks domiciled in the rRepublic will be accepted.

Sterling Cheques will be accepted as heretofore.

All entries received and not adhering to the above will be returned and an administration charge of €25 will incur.

CLASS DEFINITIONS (The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.******

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

Stakes Classes are limited to Puppy, Veteran, Brace and Team and are open to more than one breed or variety. **All exhibits in stakes classes except for those entered in Veteran Stakes,** must be entered in a standard breed class.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of four months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

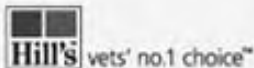
