SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **Jurisdiction:** The Show will be held under the Rules of The Irish Kennel Club Ltd., and a copy of the I. K. C. Rules and Regulations will be in the Secretary's Office on the day of the Show.
2. **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 36, Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6
3. **Venue-** The Show will be held in the **National Show Centre Cloghran, Co. Dublin**, on Saturday 19th. August 2017
4. **ENTRIES:** First Dog: €18.00 All additional entries €5.00, Junior Handling Classes all €5.00 extra. **If a Baby Puppy is the only entry they are only charged €6**
5. **Fees of exhibits** arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
6. **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
7. **Judging:** Will commence at **9.30 am. sharp**. No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the Ring.
8. **Responsibility:** Exhibitors will please understand that while every precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of an exhibit, The All Terrier Association will not be responsible for any loss or damages sustained by an exhibitor through accident or otherwise.

ALL ENGLISH/FOREIGN EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

Cheques drawn in Euro on English Banks will not be accepted as they cannot be cleared without incurring Bank Charges. Only Euro Cheques drawn on Irish Banks domiciled in the Republic will be accepted.

Sterling Cheques will be accepted as heretofore.

All entries received and not adhering to the above will be returned and an administration charge of €25 will incur.

CLASS DEFINITIONS (The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show .

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Adult Class is for dogs between between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.******

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of four months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

An Introduction to our Judges

Brian Aubrey (Jenabeck). Brian started in Staffordshire Bull Terriers in the late 70s and commenced his judging career in the early '80s; He gave his first set of CCs in 1990 and to date he has judged 11 times. He has bred and made up two Stafford Champions and handled others to their titles for their owners. Brian also awards CCs in three other terrier breeds, Parsons, Sealyhams and Border Terriers. This is Brian's second appointment in Ireland. We look forward to welcoming Brian to Ireland once again

Róbert Kanás (Flanagan) Róbert is involved with Terriers since 1992. He has judged previously in many countries worldwide. He has bred lots of Champions and has earned several European and World Winner titles, including BOB at Crufts, Westminster and Montgomery. We are delighted to welcome him to Ireland for the first time!

Vanessa Hearne (Warbonnet) Vanessa has a life long involvement in both Miniatures and Bull Terriers. Horses also played a big part in Vanessa's life, breeding, showing and judging them. Ch Warbonnet Gold-coast was a very successful stud dog, being sire to the World winner multi Ch Mooncraft Princess of Showlands. Vanessa has been judging since 1999 and awards CCs to Bull Terriers and Mini Bull Terriers and we are delighted to welcome her on the occasion of her first Irish appointment .

Charlotta Mellin (Rollick's) Charlotta has been successfully breeding Kerry Blues since the early 1980's. She has also bred Irish Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers (Irish type), Bull Terriers and Japanese Shiba Inu. She has also owned Sealyham Terriers. To date there are more than 120 Rollick's Kerry Blue Champions Worldwide. Included in this list are US Ch Rollick's Riverdance, Top Kerry in USA 2006 and Multi Ch and Worldwinner Rollick's Super Hero, multiple BIS-winner on the continent and also CC-winner at Crufts 2012. Charlotta judges Group 3 as well as breeds in other Groups. While Charlotta has judged extensively in FCI countries this is her first appointment in Ireland. She is excited to be judging Terriers and in particular the Irish breeds in their native country.

Tim Finney. Tim has been judging since 1974 and is now qualified for Groups 4, 6, 9 & 10 and several Group 3 breeds. As an exhibitor and breeder of Irish Wolfhounds and Dachshunds, he is very aware that breeds should retain their fitness for function both in conformation and temperament, and these elements will be to the fore in his assessment of the various breeds .

Jarka Poulová (Edbrios) Jarka has been involved in Kerry Blues since the early '90's. Her interest evolved into other native terriers of Ireland and further still to all Terriers. Jarka was involved in Breed and Group

Clubs in Czech. She moved to Ireland in 2003 and joined the well-known Edbrios prefix of Eddie and Philip O'Brien. Over the years they have reached some of the highest show awards with their dogs, in Ireland and also on the European and World stage. Terriers are Jarka's life-time passion. Since her first judging appointment in 2005 she has been honoured to judge in Ireland, United Kingdom, Sweden, Holland and Czech. She is delighted to have the opportunity to officiate as a Group Judge at the premier Terrier show in Ireland.
