## SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **Jurisdiction:** The Show will be held under the Rules of The Irish Kennel Club Ltd., and a copy of the I. K. C. Rules and Regulations will be in the Secretary's Office on the day of the Show.
2. **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 36, Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6
3. **Venue-** The Show will be held in the **Ferryhouse Complex, Clonmel, Co Tipperary**, on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup>. August 2019  
**ENTRIES:** First Dog: €22.00 All additional entries €8.00, Junior Handling Classes all €5.00 extra. **Baby Puppy €5. Catalogues Prepaid: €4.00, CAR PARK: €5.00**
5. **Fees of exhibits** arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
6. **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
7. **Judging:** Will commence at **11.00 am. sharp**. No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the Ring.
8. **Responsibility:** Exhibitors will please understand that while every precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of an exhibit, The All Terrier Association will not be responsible for any loss or damages sustained by an exhibitor through accident or otherwise.

### **All ENGLISH/FOREIGN EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:**

Cheques drawn in Euro on English Banks will not be accepted as they cannot be cleared without incurring Bank Charges. Only Euro Cheques drawn on Irish Banks domiciled in the Republic will be accepted.

**Sterling Cheques will be accepted as heretofore.**

### **CLASS DEFINITIONS**

**(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)**

**Baby Puppy Class** is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

**Baby Puppies** are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

**A Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show .

**A Junior Class** is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**An Intermediate Class** is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**An Adult Class** is for dogs between between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**An Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show.

**A Champions Class** is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.**\*\*\*\*

**A Veteran Class** is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

**Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**\*\*

**N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)**

**BRACE CLASS** is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

**NOTE: Dogs under the age of four months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.**

Just before her first litter was born she applied for the affix 'Molru' and under this affix has bred Irish Champions, 2 GB Champions & An American Champion. She has won 2 CCs and BOB at Crufts with Ch/Gb Ch/ Int Ch Zakstaff What's The Story At Molru and he then became the breed record holder in Ireland. Mel has previously awarded Green Stars to a number of breeds in Ireland and has been fortunate to judge breed specialities across the world. She is honoured to have been invited to Judge at The All Terrier Association I am very much looking forward to the day. We are delighted to welcome Mel to the All Terrier Association for the first time.

### **Alan Matthews**

The Craigykor kennel was founded in 1952 and Alan was born into showing and breeding dogs. He has bred Champion Kerry Blue, Cairn and Smooth Fox Terriers and owned a champion Dandie Dinmont, however they are primarily known for Welsh Pembroke Corgis. Alan is qualified to judge Group 1, 2, 5 and BIS. He has judged all over the world including America, Australia, Russia, Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland, France and the UK. Alan says meeting his lovely wife Sarah through showing dogs has been his number one highlight followed by BOB at Crufts. We are delighted to welcome Alan to the All Terrier Association for the first time.

At the moment Shaun is currently showing Nor Swed Uk Ch Zakstaff Rumour Has It Jw.

Shaun was approved by the Kennel Club to award CC's in 2014 and awarded them at SKC 2016 and EASBTC 2019 and Has judge in USA, Holland and France. Shaun is very much looking forward to the show and his first

appointment in Ireland. Shaun would like to thank the Club for inviting him to judge where he will give a honest and unbiased opinion.
