SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **Jurisdiction:** The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., as in force on the 28th October 2018
2. **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 36, Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6
Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
3. **Venue-** The Show will be held in the **National Show Centre Cloghran, Co. Dublin, on Monday 28th. October 2019.**
Catalogues : .Will be on sale within the grounds price **€5.00.**
AND CAN ALSO BE PREPAID WITH ENTRY PRICE €5.00.
CAR PARK: €5.00 ON DAY OF SHOW OR €5.00 PREPAID WITH ENTRY.
4. **ENTRIES: Service charge of €24.00 (£24 Stg.) for 1st Dog in Breed or Stakes Plus €1.00 IKC Levy**
There will be a Service Charge of €9.00 (£9 Stg) for each additional dog in the same ownership,
€9.00 (£9 Stg) each for the Puppy, Brace, Champion and Veteran Stakes.
Rosettes from 1st to 4th for all Stakes Classes
Fees of exhibits arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited.
Junior Handling €5.00 (£5.00) (Free if entered in Breed class) .
5. **No entries** will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.
Entries will be received up to and including the **23rd September, 2019** by the **Secretary: Mrs. Colette Muldoon, 20 Rosebank, Oldbawn, Tallaght, Dublin 24.**

Online entry closes at midnight on the 30th September 2019
7. **Rejection of Entries: etc. -The promoting body reserve the right to refuse any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue or the allocation of Stand space at the Show.**
8. **ENTRY FORMS : MISTAKES IN-** The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the All Ireland Bull Breeds Association cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
9. **Ineligible Entries:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to the sex or breed is allowed if reported to the secretary's office prior to the commencing of judging. A dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the open class in that breed, but in no other respects.
10. Rosettes will be given for Green Star, Best of Breed, Group, Brace, Vete4ran Stakes, Junior Handling and Best in Show Winners.Special Prizes offered for competition by or through a Specialist Club shall be collected and distributed by that Club.
11. **Exhibits:** (a) Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times; (b) every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later than 7.00 pm.
12. **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
13. **Judging:** (a) Will commence at **10.00 a.m. sharp, including Junior Handling.** No claim will be

considered in the event of an exhibit being late, (b) No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. (c) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring; (d) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the Ring.

14. **Special Prizes** offered by a Specialist Club must be collected from the Club.
15. **All announcements** appearing in the "Herald" prior to the closing of entries or in reference to any alterations made by the club in the Schedule or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice there of.
16. **Interpretation:** The Committee of the Promoting Club shall be the "Show Committee" within the meaning of the I.K.C. Rules , all disputes, if any, shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd..
17. **Accident or Damage:** The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the Show.
18. **Exercise/Puppy Pens:** are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, **at all shows** licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.
19. **Puppies under** the age of six (6) months **should not** be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.

NOTE Addition To I.K.C. RULE 7 Section 1

Every dog exhibited, or competing at any show, Field Trial or Obedience Test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. in the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds with up to date registrations from the Irish Coursing Club and dogs not of a recognised breed for which a licences have been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working Tests.

Failure to comply with the above will result in:

- (A) The Dog being disqualified from the event **and**
- (B) The exhibitor being fined €127.00

The implementation of which shall be a Normal (I.K.C.) Office Routine.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW, AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION ON THE ENTRY FORM.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.

7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Notice for schedule

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified)

If the stakes class is missed for any reason, there will be no refund.

Procedures will come into effect from the 1st January 2011

Breeds Not Separately Listed

Breeds entered in the Breeds Not Separately Listed at National Championship Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the Catalogue. A Judge may award a Green Star and Best of Breed in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded excellent or in the case of puppies "Very Promising" **Effective from 1st January 2011.**

Payment of Service Charges

Please note that Services Charges will be accepted in EURO or STERLING ONLY.

No self - conversions acceptable. Thank you.

EURO CHEQUES

Please Note

Only Euro Cheques drawn on Irish Banks will be acceptable. A Euro Cheque drawn on UK or otherwise will not be accepted.

No UK Postal Orders accepted.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 6 and under 12 months of age on the day of the Show

Junior Class is confined to dogs over 9 and under 18 months of age on the day of the Show.

Intermediate Class is confined to dogs over 15 and under 24 months on the day of the Show.

Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Open Class is confined to dog over 15 months on the day of the Show.

Champion Class is confined to dogs that have attained the title of Champion under the Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or other Kennel Authority recognised by the Irish Kennel Club.

Veteran Class is confined to dog over 8 years of age on the day of the Show

Field Trial Class is confined to dogs who have won at least a reserve in a Puppy, Novice, Derby or Open Stake as defined in the Field Trial Rules & Regulations.

A copy of the relevant win at Field Trial must accompany the entry form.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

Brace Class is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

NOTE: Baby Puppies 4 to 6 months may only enter as a second entry. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibit

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds The American Akita and the Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/ American Akita (not yet assessed)

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

We suggest that they are placed last in the order of judging, as the judge on the day will have to be absent from the ring during the assessment. It is envisaged that the number of unassessed dogs will decrease over the next six months and eventually all Akitas will be designated as American Akita or Akita Inu.
