# SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **RULES:** The Show will be held under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force on the date of the publication of this schedule and will be on display in an abridged form on the day of the Show.
2. **VENUE:** The Show will be held in the **Grounds of the Kings Hall Complex, Balmoral, Belfast BT9 6GW. ON SATURDAY 18<sup>th</sup> April 2010**
3. **THE ENTRY FEE** will be as follows:

4. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility for mistakes in the Catalogue which may bring exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Rules.
5. **PRIZES:** Trophies for Best in Show and Best Puppy in Show.
6. **THE ENTRY FEES OF EXHIBITS** failing to arrive or rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon will be forfeited.
7. **VETERINARY EXAMINATIONS:** A Veterinary Surgeon, or an authorised substitute, in attendance will have the power to exclude any exhibit which in his/ her opinion is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of disease, vice, or other cause.
8. **JUDGES:** In the event of any appointed Judge, failing to keep his/her engagement, the Committee reserve the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
9. **JUDGING:** (a) will commence at 10.00 am sharp, except Junior Handling which will commence at 9.30 am. No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late. (b) **No persons** will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. (c) **The exhibition number** of each dog which must be clearly displayed by its handler who shall not wear a

badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. **(d) The Club** will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the Ring, even though the exhibit may be on the grounds at the time of Judging. In the event of any exhibitor requesting a Steward or other Official to handle his/her exhibit in the Ring, any such Official may voluntarily do so only on the distinct understanding that such action is on behalf of the exhibitor and does not involve any responsibility whatever or any responsibility for loss or damage consequential or otherwise.

10. **RECEIPT ON ENTRIES AND DISPATCH OF EXHIBITORS NUMBERS:** No acknowledgement of receipt of entries will be sent UNLESS a stamped addressed postcard is enclosed with the entries. If exhibitors numbers have not been received five days before the Show, application should be made to the Hon. Secretary (Telephone 028 9269 9617).
11. **EXHIBITS:** Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times. **ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES ANYWHERE ON THE SHOWGROUNDS.**
12. **SALE OF DOGS:** Exhibitors may state on their entry form the price at which they are prepared to sell their dogs and all negotiations for the same must be conducted between buyers and sellers. The acceptance of a dog for exhibition shall not be taken to imply that the Promoting Body warrants or guarantees that the dog is in a fit state for exhibition or complies with the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition and the Promoting Body shall not be liable in any way whatsoever if the dog is subsequently found either to have been unfit for exhibition or not to have complied with the Regulations.
13. **REJECTING ENTRIES:** etc.: **(a)** The Promoting Body reserves the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue or the allocation of Stand Space at the Show. **(b)** No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Entry Fee, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances. **(c) INELIGIBLE ENTRIES:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in an age class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class, but in no other respects.
14. **ALL JUDGES** are requested to take classes in each breed in the order in which they are entered in the Judging Book.
15. **ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS:** appearing in "Dog World", "Our Dogs" prior to the Date of the closing of entries, and in reference to any alterations made by the Club in the Schedule, or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
16. **INTERPRETATION:** The Promoting Body shall be the "Show Committee" within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. Rules and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the Promoting Body. Parties to any such disputes shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
17. **DURING THE EXHIBITION OF DOGS** at this Show the officiating Judge will not allow, under any circumstances, any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
- 18) **Exercise/Puppy Pens:** are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, **at all shows** licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.
- 19) **Dogs not entered for competition:** Dogs which are not being exhibited at all Breed Championship Shows must be entered as **NOT FOR COMPETITION**, for insurance

purposes, prior to close of entries. Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of breed/s and name/s of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs and keep a record of same. Production of passes may be requested in any area of dispute. The fee for this facility shall be **Five Euro, (€5.00), per dog**

20) **Puppies under** the age of six (6) months **should not** be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.

## **RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING and BEST IN SHOW**

1. The Irish Kennel Club will not accept any responsibility, nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Irish Kennel Club will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners.
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it at the show.
4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into 10 sections as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their Best of Breed Rosette.
7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz., 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th. Absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups. Competition for the award of Reserve Best in Show will be confined to the winners of Groups and the 2nd winner in that Group from which came the winner of Best in Show.
9. If the Group judging has not commenced before 4.30 pm a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group Judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €25, unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging of Group commences.

**(A) The Dog being disqualified from the event and**

### **CLASS DEFINITIONS** **(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)**

**Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over 6 and under 12 months of age on the day of the Show

**Junior Class** is confined to dogs over 9 and under 18 months of age on the day of the Show.

**Intermediate Class** is confined to dogs over 15 and under 24 months on the day of the Show.

**Open Class** is confined to dog over 15 months on the day of the Show.

**Champion Class** is confined to dogs that have attained the title of Champion under the Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or other Kennel Authority recognised by the Irish Kennel Club.

**Veteran Class** is confined to dog over 8 years of age on the day of the Show

**Field Trial Class** is confined to dogs who have won at least a reserve in a Puppy, Novice, Derby or Open Stake as defined in the Field Trial Rules & Regulations.

A copy of the relevant win at Field Trial must accompany the entry form.

**Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

**N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)**

**Brace Class** is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

**Team Class** is for three exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

**NOTE:** Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibit

## Videos

**It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.**

### **FOULING**

Please keep in mind I.K.C. Rule: if your dog fouls the venue indoor or outdoor and you do not clean it up you will be fined €28.00 (£20). This year's committee will be strictly enforcing this rule. Save yourself money and clean up after your dog, and assure a comfortable venue for any future shows.

# **DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW**

The show will be held in the King's Hall Complex Balmoral. It is situated ON THE southern outskirts of Belfast, approximately 1 mile from Junction 2 of the M1 Motorway.

## **From Dublin (Driving time approx. 2 hours)**

**Please note: The M1 is a Toll Road with a charge of €1.70 South of the New Boyne Bridge at Drogheda. Euro is the only currency accepted at the Toll Piazza.**

Take the M1 from Dublin and follow signs for Belfast and the North. At end of Motorway follow signs for Newry and Belfast (N1). Between Dundalk and Newry the N1 becomes the A1, also signed to Belfast. The A1 joins the M1 (Northern) at Junction 6 at which point continue in direction of Belfast leaving Motorway at Junction 2 (See Direction below from Junction 2).

## **From Larne (Driving time approx. 45 minutes)**

Take A8 (M) following signs for Belfast. At intersection with M2 join the Motorway and continue in direction of Belfast to end of Motorway. At end of M2 join the Westlink following signs for M1, Dublin and the South. At end of Westlink join the M1 and leave at Junction 2. (See Direction below from Junction 2).

## **From Belfast Port (Driving time approx. 15 minutes)**

Join the Westlink following signs for M1, Dublin and the South, at the end of Westlink join the M1 and leave at Junction 2.

## **From M1 Junction 2**

Join A55 following signs for the King's Hall. Pass through 2 sets of traffic lights, under railway bridge, immediately through next traffic lights and after pedestrian lights turn right into Harberton Park. Entrance to Show Grounds will be indicated.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS**

There will be no access to the Show Grounds before 8.00 am. There are no facilities for overnight parking or camping. Catering facilities will be available throughout the day. In order to improve speed of entry into the Show Grounds and thereby reduce road congestion, pre-paid car passes are considerably cheaper than payment on the day. The organisers would therefore greatly appreciate exhibitors paying for such passes along with their entries.

## **Exhibitors wishing to Advertise**

The price for exhibitors wishing to place an advertisement in the Catalogue is £50.00 or €70.00 per page. Adverts and payment should be sent with entries.
