BANGOR AND NORTH DOWN CANINE CLUB SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1. Jurisdiction:** The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., as in force on the 6th August 2010
- 2. Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Fottrell House, Harold's Cross Bridge, Dublin 6
Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted with- out further registration.
- 3. Venue-** The Show will be held in the R.U.A.S. SHOWGROUNDS BALMORAL, BELFAST.

Catalogues: .Will be on sale within the grounds price £4.00 (€5.00.) AND CAN ALSO BE PREPAID WITH ENTRY PRICE £3.00 (€4.00.)

CAR PARK: £4.00 (€5.00) ON DAY OF SHOW OR £3.00 (€4.00) PREPAID WITH ENTRY.

- 4. ENTRIES:** Service charge for first Dog £18.00 (€20.00).
There will be a Service Charge of £7.00 (€8.00) for each additional dog in the same ownership, £7.00 (€8.00) each for the Puppy, Brace, Veteran Stakes and Champion Stakes. Fees of exhibits arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited.
Junior Handling if entered in breed class Free, otherwise £4.00 (€5.00) .
- 5. No entries** will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.
- 6. Entries** will be received up to and including the **28th June (postmark) 2010** by the Show Secretary:

- 7. Rejection of Entries, etc.** -The promoting body reserves the right to refuse any entry , advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue or the allocation of Stand space at the Show.
- 8. ENTRY FORMS:** The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the Bangor & North Down Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
- 9. Ineligible Entries:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in an age class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class, but in no other respects.
- 10. As there** are no Entry Fees charged, there will be no Prize Money. Prize cards will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Reserve in each Class. Rosettes will be given to Green Star Winners, Best of Breed, Best A.V.N.S.C., Group Winners to 4th. place. Best in Show and Reserve Best in show. Special Prizes offered for competition by or through a Specialist Club shall be collected and distributed by that Club.

- 11. Exhibits:** (a) Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times; (b) every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later than 7.00 pm.
- 12. Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement or should his or her entries exceed 150 dogs, the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
- 13. Judging:** (a) Will commence at **9.30 a.m.** sharp, **except Junior Handling and Golden Retrievers which will commence at 9.00 a.m..** No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late, (b) No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. (c) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler. who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. (d) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring.
- 14. Special Prizes** offered by a Special Club must be collected from the Club.
- 15. All announcements** appearing in the “Dog Press” prior to the closing of entries or in reference to any alterations made by the club in the Schedule or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof
- 16. Interpretation.** The Committee of the Promoting Club shall be the “Show Committee” within the meaning of the I.K.C. Rules; all disputes, if any, shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- 17. Accident or Damage.** The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
- 18. Exercise/Puppy Pens:** are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, **at all shows** licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.
- 19. Dogs not entered for competition:** Dogs which are not being exhibited at all Breed Championship Shows must be entered as **NOT FOR COMPETITION**, for insurance purposes, prior to close of entries. Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of breed/s and name/s of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs and keep a record of same. Production of passes may be requested in any area of dispute. The fee for this facility shall be **Five Euro, (€5 00), per dog.**
- 20. Puppies under** the age of six (6) months **should not** be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.

NOTE Addition to I.K.C. Rule 7 Section 1.

Every dog exhibited, or competing at any Show, Field Trial or Obedience Test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. In the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club, and dogs not of a recognised breed for which licences have been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working Test.

Failure to comply with the above will result in: (A) The dog being disqualified from the event and (B) the exhibitor being fined €127.00.

The implementation of this will be a normal (I.K.C.) Office routine.

INTRODUCING OUR JUDGES

JOAN WILLIAMSON – ‘Sonrich & Cooneen’ - Our Best in Show judge. Joan has been in dogs a lifetime, first showing Great Danes under her ‘Sonrich’ prefix and then Kerry Blues. She later shared the ‘Cooneen’ prefix with her late husband, Cecil, when Pembroke Corgis became their main interest, and many Cooneens were made up here and in GB. Miniature Schnauzers were also part of the household, the latest Champion being crowned in late ‘09. Joan’s first judging appointment was at Dublin Dog Show in 1970, and she judged BIS at Combined Canine Club in 1988. She judges all breeds bar gundogs, and has judged in Norway, New Zealand and USA. Joan also awards CCs in Corgis. We hope she has an enjoyable day at Bangor with a great BIS lineup to choose from.

ANNE INDERGAARD – ‘Annwn’ - from Trondheim in Norway, now a board member of the Norwegian KC, grew up with Norwegian Buhunds but the 1st dog in her own name was a multi CC winning German Shepherd. Her parents got their first Welsh Corgi Pembroke about 40 years ago, and since then she has been breeding and showing Welsh Corgis under the Annwn prefix, titling more than 30 Annwns, from about the same number of litters. She has made up to Champion, a Miniature Schnauzer, and her first litter of Jack Russell Terriers is in the offing. First qualified to judge at Ch level 16 years ago, she now gives CCs in over 120 breeds, and has judged in most European countries and Australia & USA. A specialist for Corgis & the Norwegian breeds, we welcome her on her 1st appointment to Bangor to judge Group 5 breeds, the Group and also Group 1.

SIV SANDØ – from Trondheim in Norway, has been involved with dogs for the last 35 years. Her own breed is Labradors, but she has also had Pointers and Sussex Spaniels. She breeds, shows and works her Labradors as much as her time allows; Siv is also

involved in dog clubs, arranging seminars, shows and field trials, and is a board member of the Norwegian Kennel Club. She has been judging for the past ten years, both at home and abroad and is authorised to judge FCI group 7, and most of group 8- excepting some spaniels. We welcome her on her first visit to Bangor.

STEVEN SEYMOUR – ‘Beagriff’ - from Australia via Cambridge – at home in Oz, Steven bred Beagles whilst his late Mother, Jill, was devoted to Griffons, hence the Beagriff prefix, which is known as one of the most important Griffon prefixes in Australia. Steven judges worldwide under his FCI qualifications which allow him to judge Groups 3, 4, 6, 9 & 10 and also some Group 2 & 5. This is Steven’s second visit to Bangor, as he judged at our first Ch Show 7 years ago, and we welcome him again, this time to judge Dachshunds, some Terriers, Shar Pei and Groups 4 & 6.

MARION SPAVIN – ‘Dialynne’ - Marion is a very well known and popular judge from England. An FCI All Breeds judge, she is no stranger to Irish exhibitors, being a popular addition to many Irish judging panels, and we welcome her back to Bangor to judge some Group 9 breeds plus Groups 7 & 8.

LUIS PINTO TEIXEIRA - Luis is a renowned FCI All Breeds judge from Portugal, respected the world over for his opinions, and a popular judge in all breeds. We are delighted that he was able to accept our invitation to Bangor, where he will judge Group 2 breeds and also Groups 2 & 9. Luis judged group 8 & 9 breeds at the Euro Show in Dublin, and previously judged at Dundalk in ‘08. We hope you will give him a good entry in his breeds and that he enjoys his time with us.

DR CRISTIAN VANTU - ‘**Insolens**’ – from Romania began showing English Cocker Spaniels when he was 12 years old and since 2002 he has been breeding Azawakhs with great success. Over 25 years he had bred or owned multi International Champions. In 2006 he was commended by the Romanian Kennel Club for his contribution to the standardization and the FCI acceptance of the Romanian Shepherds. As the Vice President of the Mures County Kennel Club, he was one of the organizers of the famous “Dracula Dog Show”, the biggest and the only Crufts qualification show in Romania. He has been judging at International level since 1998 all over Europe, Russia & Scandinavia. Recently as a busy Physician working both in Romania and the UK, he has less time for dog shows as he had the past, so we are happy to welcome him to Bangor on his first ever appointment in Ireland, to judge Cockers, Labradors & Golden Retrievers as well as Group 10.

ROGER WRIGHT – Rotella – Roger is a KC Terrier Group judge and at Bangor he will judge all the Terriers in Group 3 that he is passed for by the KC London plus Group 3. He has been breeding and exhibiting West Highland White Terriers with great success over 40 years though more recently, in 2003, he ventured into Miniature Wire Haired Dachshunds, and is enjoying considerable success with his new breed. Roger’s book, The West Highland White Terrier, was published in 1992. We hope he receives a good entry for the show and enjoys his day with us.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.******

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

FIELD TRIAL CLASS is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stake.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; Great Japanese Dog and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed.
(Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed))

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas; three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

Videos

It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.

(Subject to Regulation 13 page 3)

FOULING

Please keep in mind I.K.C. Rule, if your dog fouls the venue indoor or outdoor and you do not clean it up you will be fined £20. This year's committee will strictly enforce this rule. Save yourself money and clean up after your dog, and at the same time you will be assured of a comfortable venue to show your dog next year.

TRADE STANDS

All stands must be pre booked and an up to date copy of their Public Liability Insurance must be provided when booking.

Closing Date for Bookings is the 24th. July 2010

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW

The show will be held in the Grounds Of the King’s Hall Complex Balmoral. It is situated on the Southern outskirts of Belfast, approximately 1 mile from Junction 2 of the M1 Motorway.

From Dublin (Driving time approximately 2 hours)

Please Note: The M1 is a Toll Road with a charge of €1.90 South of the New Boyne Bridge at Drogheda. Euro is the only currency accepted at the Toll Plaza.

Take M1 from Dublin and follow signs for Belfast and The North. At end of motorway carry straight on following signs for Belfast on A1. The A1 joins the M1 (Northern) at Junction 6 at which point continue in direction of Belfast leaving Motorway at Junction 2 (See directions below from Junction 2).

From Larne (Driving time approximately 45 minutes)

Take A8 (M) following signs for Belfast. At intersection with M2 join the Motorway and continue in direction of Belfast to end of Motorway. At end of M2 join the West link following signs for M1, Dublin and the South. At end of Westlink join the M1 and leave at Junction 2. (See Direction below from Junction 2)

From Belfast Port (Driving time approximately 15 minutes)

Join the Westlink following signs for M1, Dublin and the South. At end of Westlink join the M1 and leave at Junction 2.

From M1 Junction 2.

Join A55 following signs for King’s Hall. Pass through two sets of traffic lights, under railway bridge, immediately through next traffic lights and after pedestrian lights turn right into Harberton Park. Entrance to show ground will be indicated.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

There are no facilities for overnight parking or camping.
