# SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO EXHIBITORS

1. The Show will be held under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club and a copy of the Rules will be posted in the office of the Secretary on the day of the Show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
2. **Date:** The Show will be held on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2017 at The National Show Centre, Cloghran, Co. Dublin.
3. **ENTRY FEES:** The entry fee will be €20.00 first dog includes catalogue and additional dogs €10.00 . €45 for any amount in same ownership.

**ENTERING EXHIBITS:** Entries will be received up to and including 16<sup>th</sup> June 2017 (postmark). Entries must be made on the form issued for this purpose. Entry forms must be completed in ink. Details of entries and fees to be sent to the **Show Secretary, Ms. L. Mills, Rooves Moor, Coachford, Co. Cork. Tel: 087 2352723**

**ENTRY FORMS:** The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by Exhibitors, and the Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes therein.

4. **REJECTING ENTRIES:** etc.: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry,
5. **REGISTRATIONS:** All Dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club.
6. **PRIZE CARDS** will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Reserve in each Class. Rosettes will be given to Green Star winners, and Best of Breed, Best Puppy, Best Veteran
7. **PRIZES WITHHELD:** A Judge shall be empowered to withhold any prize, prizes or Green Stars if in his (or her) opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
8. **CATALOGUES:** will be on sale €3.00.
9. **JUDGES:** If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her engagement, the Committee reserves the right to employ another judge.
10. **JUDGING:**
  - (a) **Will not commence before 2pm**
  - (b) No person will be allowed in Judging Ring, except the Judge, Show Official or any exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.
  - (c) Exhibitors will not be allowed to wear a badge or other decoration in the Breed Judging Ring save the exhibition number of each dog which must be clearly displayed by the exhibitor.
  - (d) During the exhibition of Dogs at this show the officiating Judge will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ring-siders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.

**FOULING:** A minimum fine of €50.00 shall be imposed on any exhibitor who fails to clean up fouling by their dogs in the precincts of the show.  
**ALL DOGS** competing must be on a lead, unless when under a judge.

**CLASS DEFINITIONS**

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

**Baby Puppy Class** is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

**Baby Puppies** are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

**Minor Puppy Class** is confined to puppies of six months and under nine months of age on the first day of the show.

**A Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**A Junior Class** is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**An Intermediate Class** is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**An Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**A Champions Class** is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.**\*\*\*\*

**A Veteran Class** is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

**\*\*\*\* Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.\*\***

**N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)**

**NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.**
