SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **JURISDICTION:** The Show will be held under the licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force in June 2010
2. **REGISTRATION etc.** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
3. **VENUE:** The Show will be held at **Ferryhouse Sports Complex, Waterford Road, Clonmel, 15th August, 2010**
Car Park €5.00, Catalogue €5.00 or £5.00 Stg.
4. **ENTRIES:** First Dog €20.00 or (20.00 Stg.). All other dogs and/or entries by the same owner €7.00 (£7.00 stg) per class. Dogs registered in partnerships or joint owners are treated as separate entries even when forwarded by single owners.
Stakes Classes: €7.00 or £7.00 Stg per dog/class
Junior Handling: €5.00 (£5.00 Stg) if not entered in breed, Fees of exhibitors arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.
Entries will be received up to and including the 21st June 2010 (Postmark) by the Show Secretary:
Mrs. M. O’Gorman 4 Catherine Street, Clonmel, Co. Tipperary Ireland.
5. **REJECTING ENTRIES etc.:** The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue or allocation of stand space at the show.
6. **INELIGIBLE ENTRIES:** if before judging of a class or classes in which his dog is entered, an exhibitor reports that he has entered a dog in a class for which it is not eligible .he may be permitted to transfer his entry to the equivalent class or classes for the correct Breed or sex. No other transfer of an ineligible entry is permitted.
7. **ENTRY FORMS (mistakes in):** The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by exhibitors .and while every endeavour will be made to have forms correctly interpreted. the promoting body cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes therein.
8. **As there are no entry fees being charged, there will be no prize money. Special prizes offered for competition by or through a specialist club shall be collected and distributed by that club.**
9. **VETERINARY EXAMINATION:** The Veterinary Surgeon on call will have the power to exclude any exhibit which in his opinion .is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of Disease, lice or other cause.

- 10 **Judges:** In the event of any appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
- 11 **JUDGING:** Breed Judging will commence at 9.00 a.m. sharp. **Junior handling 1.00 p.m. sharp.** No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late.
- 12 No person will be allowed in the Judging ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an Exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring. The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring at the time of judging.
- 13 **SALE OF DOGS:** Exhibitors may state on their entry forms the price at which they are prepared to sell exhibits, and a sale shall take place if an offer to purchase, at the price stated be lodged with the Secretary, but no sale may be concluded until the hour of 3 o'clock on the day of the Show; and if there are, at that time, two or more intending purchasers for the same dog, the Show Committee shall have discretion to have such dog sold by auction.
- 14 **ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS** appearing in the "Dog World", prior to the date of closing of entries and in reference to any alterations made by the committee in the schedule or in these regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
- 15 **Interpretation:** The Committee of the Clonmel and District Canine Society shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. rules, and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd..
- 16 **ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE:** The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
- 17 **EXHIBITS:** Each exhibitor shall be responsible to keep their exhibits under proper control at all times. Every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later than 6 p.m.

RULES FOR JUDGING

1. The promoting body will not accept any responsibility, nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in these particular Groups or for best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place, The promoting body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, or for Best in Show, owing to the judging of its breeds not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. An award for Best of Breed shall not be operative for Group judging in the case of any dog from which a prize has been withheld for want of merit.
3. Entry in Group classes will be confined to undefeated winners, i.e. to dogs which have been awarded Best of Breed cards, save in the cases where a green Star has been withheld for want of merit, when the holder of the Best of Breed card will not be eligible to compete.
4. An entry fee will not be payable for any of the Groups or for best in Show
5. Groups will be divided into 10 sections as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the ring competitors must produce their best of breed rosettes won on the day.
7. In each Group the Judges shall pick Best of Group, Reserve Best of Group, 3rd and 4th place awards, absentees must be marked.
8. Winners of Groups will be entitled to compete for the award of Best in Show. Competition for the award of Reserve Best in Show will be confined to the winners of groups and the reserve winner in the Group from which the winner of best in Show was picked.
9. If the Group has not commenced before 4.30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the Show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group Judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €25, unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging of the Group commences.
10. During the exhibition of dogs, the judge officiating will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.

NOTE: New Rule, Dogs under six months old may not be shown , except at Breed Club Shows where Baby Puppy Classes are scheduled.

Dogs entered in these classes may not compete for any other award.

Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. (excepting the above) Dogs entered in restricted classes must also be entered in one of the Standard Classes for the breed. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the **Irish Kennel Club** in the name of the Exhibitor

Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show.

**** Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.****

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; American Akita and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed)

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

Videos

It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.
