SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1. JURISDICTION: The Show will be held under the licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. and a copy of the Rules will be posted in the office of the Secretary on the day of the show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
- VENUE & Date: The Show will be held at The National Show Centre, Cloghran, Swords, Co. Dublin on SUNDAY 12th. May 2024. (Showgrounds open at 7.00am.)
- 3. ENTRY FEES: The entry fee will be based on the following scale:(Figures in brackets denote Sterling) Dogs registered in partnerships or joint owners are treated as separate entries even when forwarded by single owners.

- a) ENTRY FORMS (mistakes in): The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by exhibitors and while every endeavour will be made to have forms correctly interpreted. the Drogheda & District Show Association cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring exhibitors within the purview of Irish Kennel Club Rule 15, Section 1, or for clerical mistakes that may occur during compilation.
- b) **REJECTING ENTRIES etc.**: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry. advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue or allocation of stand space at the show.
- 4. **INELIGIBLE ENTRIES:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in an age class for

- which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class if applicable in that breed otherwise to Open Class but in no other respects.
- 5. REGISTRATION etc. All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club, Unit 36 Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6W. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
- 6. Prizes: Prize cards will be given to 1st 2nd 3rd and reserve in each class. Rosettes will be given to Best of Breed, Group Winners, Reserve Group Winners, Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.
- Special prizes offered for competition by or through a specialist club shall be collected and distributed by that club.
- **8. VETERINARY EXAMINATION:** The Veterinary Surgeon on call will have the power to exclude any exhibit which in his opinion .is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of Disease, lice or other cause.
- 9. EXHIBITS: Each exhibitor shall be responsible to keep their exhibits under proper control at all times. Every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later than a half hour after completion of the judging of Best in Show.
- 9. Judges: In the event of any appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges. The right is reserved to the Show Committee to change a judge in a breed or breeds, or part of a breed, if it is considered such a change is in the best interest of the show
- **10. JUDGING:** Judging will commence at 10.00 a.m. Sharp. No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late. **Junior Handling at 9.30am.**
- a) No person will be allowed in the Judging ring except the Judge ,Show Officials, or an Exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.
- b) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring.
- c) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring at the time of judging.
- 11. Judges Decision: The decision of a judge at the termination of his or her judging a class shall be final, except in the case of an objection properly made and upheld under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., where a judge states that a clerical or other mistake was made in an award as Officially returned, or on the ground of fraud.
- **12. Protest:** all protests and objections must be made in the manner specified in Irish Kennel Club Ltd. Rules 13, 15, 17.
- **13.** Interpretation: The Committee of the Promoting Club shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. rules, and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd..
- **14. ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE**: The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits ,exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
- **15. ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS** appearing in the Daily Newspaper or other publication, in reference to any alterations made by the Committee in the schedule or in these regulations .shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
- **16. Exercise/Puppy Pens:** are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, <u>at all shows</u> licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.

17) Puppies under the age of six (6) months <u>should not</u> be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

- 1. The Irish Kennel Club will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Irish Kennel Club will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
- Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed
- **3.** No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in it's breed at the show.
- **4.** A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
- **5.** Groups will be divided into ten sections as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
- **6.** Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
- 7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
- **8.** Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best In Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
- 9. If the Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed win ner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits quali fied for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; Great Japanese Dog and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed) At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas; three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

Videos

It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.****

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

FIELD TRIAL CLASS is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stake.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

TEAM CLASS is for three or more exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

Cropped Dogs

Cropped dogs are not permitted to be exhibited at any Irish Kennel Club licenced event.

Neuter Class:

The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.


Special Beginners Stakes; To be eligible to compete, neither the owner/handler or the dog will have won a Green Star prior to the entry closing date of the show.
