Introducing the Judge for Foyle & Sperrin Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club Championship show 01/09/18

My experience in Staffords dates back to 1986 when my introduction to the breed happened through meeting my husband Michael and entering the Sing family. The Sings had successfully exhibited and bred Staffords under renowned prefix Cerabah for many years.

It didn't take long for my interest to grow into what was to be a life changing dedication and passion for this wonderful breed after I acquired and fell in love with my first Stafford *Ch Cherabah Son of Samson* who was not only my introduction but became a key part of my own lines with a champion bitch from his first sired litter *Ch Cherabah Carbon Copy*. She was not only a speciality CC winner but also a producer herself, and the grandmother of *Ch Cherabah Ironside*, a renowned dog of his time in Australia.

I then went on to breed some lovely champion Stafford dogs under the Cherabah prefix. I have had the privilege of breeding:

SCC Ch Cerabah Born To Be Wild, Ch Chereabah Quicksilver, SBIS Ch Cerabah Ironside, Ch Cherabah She's So Fine, Ch Cherabah Dirty Harry, CH CHERabah Sugar Maid, Ch CHERabah High Acclaim, SBIS Cherabah Lacey, Ch Cherabah, Charisma, Cherabah Paint Me Black, Ch Cherabah Razzamatazz.

With many Speciality show winnings and placings, as well as too many wins to mention on the all-breeds circuit. We have also imported three Staffords from both the UK from renowned affixes Eastaff and Knockon and one from NZ to help improve our breeding and gene pool.

After years of breeding and showing under that prefix, I ventured off in a new direction and the 'Pranksta' prefix was born in 2007.

I felt the next step for me was to attain my judging licence (also in 2007) and since then, I have had the privilege of judging and awarding CCs at Stafford Championship shows in Australia and around the globe.

Classification for Breed Club Shows

DOGS

Baby Puppy Puppy Junior Intermediate Adult Open Champion Veteran

BITCHES

DEFINITION OF CLASSES AT BREED CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

(All age classes computed from date of birth.)

A Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 4 and less than 6 months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition except Best Baby Puppy in Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. (.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.***

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth..

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

Dogs entered in restricted classes must also be entered in one of the Standard Classes for the breed. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

Any person failing to observe any provisions of the code of ethics may be dealt with under the disciplinary rule of the Irish Kennel Club

Effective 01/01/1995

Section 1 Rule 7 Regulation

Every dog exhibited, or competing at any show, field trial or obedience test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, in the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club and dogs of a non registered breed for which licences have been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working Tests.

Failure to comply with the above will result in (a) The dog being disqualified from the event and (b) The exhibitor being fined, the implementation of which shall be a normal office routine.

All appeals to the Irish Kennel Club should carry a refundable fee if the appeal is upheld.
