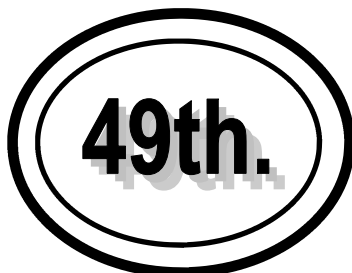

Show rules, Regulations and Instructions To Exhibitors

- 1) *The Show will be held under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club*
Venue: The show will take place at the National Show Centre Cloughran on Sat. 27th October 2018
- 2) *Entry Fee: €20 for first dog*
€ 5 for additional dogs (same owner)
Stakes Classes: € 3 per dog
(Stakes Class Exhibits must be entered in a breed class)
Catalogue & Car Park €4.00 prepaid €5 on show day
Entries: *will be received by the Show Secretary up to 5th October 2018*

- a) **Rejection of entries:** *The committee reserves the right to reject any entry advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue.*
- b) **Ineligible entries:** *a transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex may be allowed by the secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate eage class in that breed but in no other respects.*
- c) **Registrations:** *All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. Unit 36 Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6.*
- d) **Entry Forms: Mistakes in :** *The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by the exhibitors and while every endeavour will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted the Irish Gundog Field and Show Society cannot accept responsibility for mistakes which may bring exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. Rule 15, Sect 1 or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation*
- 4) **Judging:** *Judging will commence in all rings at 10.30 a.m. Show opens at 8.30am. Puppy, Veteran and brace Stakes will take place throughout the day exhibitors are asked to listen to announcements on the pa system within the venue.*
- 5) **Judges:** *In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keepHis/Her engagement the committee reserve the right to employ the services of another judge.*
- 6) **Car park & Catalogue:** *Prepaid €4 or €5 on show day*
- 7) **The promoting Body** *will not be responsible for any loss damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.*

- 8) *The promoting Body will not be responsible for any loss damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.*
- 9) *Dogs Not Entered For Competition:* *Dogs which are not being exhibited at a Group Championship show must be entered as not for competition at time of entry giving the name and breed of dog. The fee for this facility is €5 per dog. The Show Promoting Body shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs. Production of passes may be requested in an area of dispute. Only dogs entered for exhibition or not for competition will be admitted to the show.*
- 10) *Puppies* *under the age of 6 months should not be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a baby puppy class is scheduled.*
- 11) *Exercise/Puppy Pens:* *are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area at all shows licensed by the Irish Kennel Club.*

Ring Numbers will be posted prior to the Show

All aisles between rings are to be kept clear of cages and grooming tables.

CLASSIFICATION FOR ALL BREEDS

Stakes Classes: Puppy Stakes Junior Stakes Veteran Stakes, Brace Stakes,

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs from six to twelve months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.***

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

FIELD TRIAL CLASS is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stake.

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.:A Dog or Bitch may be entered in **ONE BREED CLASS ONLY** (No double entries)
