- Venue: The Show will take place at The National Show Centre, Cloghran on Sat. 23<sup>rd</sup>
   February 2019
- Service Charge of €6.00 for the first dog. €5.00 for additional dogs/ classes. (same owner) Brace €3.00
- 4. Entries: will be received by the Secretary up to 1<sup>st</sup> February 2019. (Postmark)
- 5. Rejection of entries: The committee reserves the right to reject any entry advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue.
- 6. Ineligible entries: A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex may be allowed by the secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class in that breed but in no other respects.
- 7. Registrations: All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., Unit 36 Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6.
- 8. Entry Forms: Mistakes in: The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by the exhibitors and while every Endeavour will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted the Labrador Retriever Club of Ireland cannot accept responsibility for mistakes which may bring exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. Rule 15, Section 1 or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation
- 9. **Judging:** Judging will commence in all rings at 11 30a.m. sharp.
- 10. **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his/her engagement the committee reserve the right to employ the services of another judge.
- 11. The promoting Body will not be responsible for any loss damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.

### CLASS DEFINITIONS (The word "Dog" includes both sexes)

A Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 4 and less than 6 months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition except Best Baby Puppy in Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs of 6 months and under the age of 12 months on the day of the Show.

**A Junior Class** is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

**An Adult Class** is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show. vii. Champion Class is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Limited rules or under another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

A Champion Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.\*\*\*\*

**Veteran Class** is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show. Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

**Field Trial Class** is confined to dogs who have won at least a reserve in a Puppy, Novice, Derby or Open Stake as defined in the Field Trial Rules & Regulations.

**Trophies for:** Best in Show, Best Dog, Best Bitch.

Rosettes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and Reserve in all classes.


