SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **Jurisdiction:** The show will be held under the rules and regulations of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.as in force on the 7th July 2019 and a copy of the Licence will be posted in the secretary's office on the day of the show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
2. **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without any further registrations.
3. **Venue:** The Show will be held at Manor St John Lisduggan Waterford City
4. **Entries:**

First Entry is €22.00 (£22) inclusive of the IKC levy and then €8.00 (£8) for every entry thereafter in the same ownership.
€8 (£8) for entry into stakes classes (Champion, Veteran, Brace, Team, Junior, Puppy) Rosettes from 1st to 4th in all stakes classes.
Junior Handling €5 (£5) (free if entered in the breed)
Not for competition €5 (£5)
Catalogue €3.00. prepaid or €4.00 non the day.
5. Fees of exhibits late or failing to arrive will be forfeited.
6. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate service charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.
7. Postal entries will be received up to and including the closing date 10th June 2019 by the Secretary:

8. **Rejecting Entries:** The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, advert or other insertion into the catalogue.
9. **Ineligible Entries:** If before judging of a class or classes in which a dog entered, an exhibitor reports he/she has entered the dog in a class for which it is not eligible he/she may be permitted to transfer his/her entry to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed or sex. No other transfers of an ineligible entry are permitted.
10. **Entry Forms (mistakes in):** The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by exhibitors and while every endeavour will be made to have the forms correctly interoperated the promoting body cannot accept responsibility for mistakes therein.
11. Rosettes will be given for Greenstars, Best of breeds, Best in Show, Best Puppy, Best Baby Puppy, Best Junior, Best Brace, Best Champion and Best Veteran. Special prizes offered for competition by or through a specialist club or individual shall be collected and distributed by the club.
12. **Veterinary Examination:** The Veterinary Surgeon on call will have the power to exclude any exhibit, which in his opinion, is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of Disease, lice or other cause.
13. **Judges:** In the event of any appointed Judge failing to keep his/her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge/Judges.

14. **Judging:** (a) will commence at 11am. (b) No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. (c) The Exhibition number of each dog must be displayed clearly by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. (d) The Munster Terrier Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the Ring.
15. All announcements appearing in the Canine Press or Social Media prior to the closing of entries or in reference to any alterations made by the Club in the schedule or in these regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
16. **Interpretation:** The Committee of the Munster Terrier Club within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Club Rules, all disputes if any, shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club.
17. **Responsibility:** The Munster Terrier Club will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.
18. All Exhibits must be kept on leads. Each Exhibitor shall be responsible to keep their exhibits under proper control at all times. Every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent within 1 hour of completion of judging.
19. **Accident or Damage:** The Munster Terrier Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accidents by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show
20. **Exercise / Puppy pens:** are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area at all shows licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.
21. Puppies under the age of 6 months are not permitted on the show grounds unless they are being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.

No late entries will be accepted

Note Addition to I.K.C. Rule 7 Section 1

Every dog exhibited, or competing at any show, Field Trial or Obedience Test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. in the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club and dogs not of a recognised breed for which licences have been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working tests.

Failure to comply with the above will result in:

The Dog being disqualified from the event and The exhibitor being fined €130.00

The implementation of which shall be a normal (I.K.C) office routine.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW, AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION ON THE ENTRY FORM.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place.
2. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
3. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
4. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been with-held from it in its breed at the show.
5. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
6. Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
7. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
8. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
9. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
10. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences

Notice for schedule

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group. All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only. A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified)

Procedures will come into effect from the 1st January 2011

Breeds Not Separately Listed

Breeds entered in the Breeds Not Separately Listed at National Championship Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the Catalogue. A Judge may award a Green Star and Best of Breed in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded excellent or in the case of puppies "Very Promising" Effective from 1st January 2011.

Payment Service Charges

Please note that Services Charges will be accepted in EURO or STERLING ONLY. No self - conversions acceptable. Thank you.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show. Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 6 and under 12 months of age on the day of the Show

Junior Class is confined to dogs over 9 and under 18 months of age on the day of the Show.

Intermediate Class is confined to dogs over 15 and under 24 months on the day of the Show.

Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Open Class is confined to dog over 15 months on the day of the Show.

Champion Class is confined to dogs that have attained the title of Champion under the Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or other Kennel Authority recognised by the Irish Kennel Club.

Veteran Class is confined to dog over 8 years of age on the day of the Show

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

Brace Class is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

NOTE: Baby Puppies 4 to 6 months may only enter as a second entry. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibit
