Date: The Show will be held on Sunday 9th June 2024, GREGG'S KENNELS, 89 Moss Road, Carryduff, Belfast. BT8 8HX

- 2. ENTRY FEES: €11.00 (£10.00) for the first dog, €6.00 (£5.00) for each subsequent dog. Baby Puppy €6.00(£5.00) Stakes Classes €11.00 (£10.00)
- 4. **ENTERING EXHIBITS**: Entries will be received up to and **including 26thMay 2024 (postmark) and online <u>www.dogshowentry.ie</u> at midnight the 1st June 2024**

- 5. **REJECTING ENTRIES**: etc.: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry,
- 6. **REGISTRATIONS**: All Dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club.
- 7. **JUDGES**: If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her engagement, the Committee reserves the right to employ another judge.
- 8. **JUDGING**:
- (a) Will not commence before 1.00pm. No claim will be considered for any exhibit arriving late.
- (b) No person will be allowed in Judging Ring, except the Judge, Show Official or any exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.
- (c) Exhibitors will not be allowed to wear a badge or other decoration in the Breed Judging Ring save the exhibition number of each dog which must be clearly displayed by the exhibitor.
- (d) During the exhibition of Dogs at this show the officiating Judge will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ring-siders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
- 10. Accident or damage: The promoting body will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained by an exhibitor through accident or otherwise. (b) The promoting body will not be responsible for any accident, that may occur to any exhibitor or other person attending the Show.
- 11. **ROSETTES:** will be given to All Best of Breeds, Best in Show, Res. Best in Show, Best Baby Puppy in Show, Best Puppy in Show, Best Junior in Show, Best Intermediate in Show. Best Veteran, Champion Stakes.
- 12. Champion Stakes, winner £15.00, Second £10.00, Third £5.00. To be judged after Best in Show

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 4 and under 6 months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition except Best Baby Puppy In Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs from six to twelve months of age on the day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

NB. There is no **Champions Breed Class** at this show, Champions can only compete in
