Introducing our Judge



Hello everybody!

My name is Cathrin Lundberg Westin. I am 55 years and live in Täby, a suburb to Stockholm in Sweden ,with my husband, youngest daughter Amanda (22 years)) and our pugs. For a living I work as an Inspector at the police force.

I am sitting in the boarder for the Swedish judgement Association. I have been working in the border for the Swedish Pug Club for 4 years.

It will be a pleasure to come Ireland and judging your pugs. I was very happy about the invitation, thank you!

Here is some words about myself: In my younger days I had several working dogs, one Great Danes and two Bearded Collie.

I followed a friend of mine to buy a tibble puppy and we left the kennel with one puppy each!

I started to breed Tibetan Spaniels in 1989 under the prefix P´zazz and breed them for 25 years.

During that time began my youngest daughter Amanda exhibit in Junior Handling. She thought the tibbies was boring to show (tibbies not appreciate candy as much as our pugs do) so we bought a pug bitch for her. Since the day our first pug, CH Puggens Party Girl, stepped into our home I have loved the breed. For me it´s a perfect dog that have so much that I want out of a dog. They give so much love and joy in everyday life and are such incredibly good friends. So one pug quickly became two pugs and now I have been breeding them for six years.

I have been judging pugs in different countries in Scandinavia and in Lithuania and I must say that so far it feels like many breeders have the same goal in type but do not think so much about coat, pigments and some other details that are important in the breed.

SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **JURISDICTION.** The show will be held under licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. As in force on 1st July 2017.
2. **All dogs must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.**
3. **Venue** - the show will be held at The National Show Grounds Cloghran Co Dublin on Saturday 1st July 2017. Between the hours of 9am and 6pm judging will commence at 12 noon. Entries will be received up to and including Friday 9th June 2017 by the secretary: **Mr W R Kilpatrick, Kerronmor House, Woodrooffe, Clonmel, Co Tipperary. Tel 052 6135288.** The promoting body shall have the right to refuse any entry.
Online closes at midnight on the 16th June 2017
4. **ENTRIES-ENTRY FEE of €15 for first entry and €5 for each dog thereafter.**
5. **There will be an entry fee of €2 for dogs entered in all stakes classes.**
6. **No entries will be accepted without the appropriate fees, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.**
7. **JUDGING** - If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her appointment, the committee reserves to employ another judge. The right is reserved to the promoting body to change in a breed if it is considered such a change is in the best interests of the show.
8. The promoting body shall not be responsible for the exhibition of any dog in the ring. In the event of an exhibitor requesting a Steward or other official to handle his or her exhibit in the ring, any such official may voluntarily do so but on the distinct understanding that such an action is on behalf of the owner and does not involve the promoting body in any responsibility whatever for loss or damage consequential or otherwise.
9. **JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT 12 NOON SHARP.**
10. **CATALOGUES** - The promoting body shall not be responsible for any loss, direct or indirect, occasioned by any mistake or omission in the Catalogue. In any such case the exhibitor should immediately inform the ring Steward if the judging is in progress and otherwise the exhibitor should immediately report the Catalogue inaccuracy at the Secretary's Office.
11. **NOTICE** - All announcements appearing in the Dog columns of the national Press prior to the date of the closing of entries and in reference to any alterations made by the promoting body in the Schedule or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
12. **EXHIBITS** - Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibit under proper control at all times. **ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES ANYWHERE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.**
13. **INTERPRETATION** - The committee of the promoting club shall be the " Show Committee" within the meaning of The Irish Kennel Club rules, and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to The Irish Kennel Club.
14. **ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE** - The Society will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the Show through accident or otherwise.
15. **FOULING** - Every exhibitor will be required to remove and dispose in bins provided any fouling made by their dogs in any part of the show grounds.
16. **EXHIBITORS ARE REQUESTED TO BRING THEIR OWN SCOOP OR PLASTIC BAG FOR**

THIS PURPOSE.

17. **JUDGING RING** - No person will be allowed in any judging ring except the judge Show Official or exhibitor taking dogs in for adjudication.
18. **PLEASE NOTE** - Entry fee €15 for first dog. €5 for each extra dog.
19. **Stakes classes** €2 extra.

DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES

Please keep in mind I.K.C. Rule, if your dog fouls the venue indoor or outdoor and you do not clean it up you will be fined €25. This year's committee will strictly enforce this rule.

Save yourself money and clean up after your dog, and at the same time you will be assured of a comfortable venue to show your dog next year.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over four and under six months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show .

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, .

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, .

An Adult class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, .

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.******

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

****** Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.****

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

NOTE: Entrants in Special Colour Classes inclusive must also be entered in one of the Main classes

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds unless entered in schedule Baby Puppy Class. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.
