CLASS DEFINITIONS

A Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 4 and less than 6 months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition except Best Baby Puppy in Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs of 6 months and under the age of 12 months on the day of the Show.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show.

Champion Class is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Limited rules or under another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under the rules and regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show. Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

Special Pre Veteran Class is for dogs over six years and under eight years of age on the day of the Show. Please note – a Dog who has attained the title Champion may enter in either Pre Veteran or Champion Class but not both. This Class may only be scheduled at Breed Club Shows only.

A Brace Class is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

A Breeders Class is for a minimum of three and a maximum of five exhibits of the same breed and variety without distinction of sex bred by the same person (same kennel name) even if they are not his/her property.

A progeny Class is for a sire or dam with a minimum of three and a maximum of five of his/her progeny, / 1st generation sons/daughters.

The decisive date in respect of age is the day the dog is shown.

SHOW REGULATIONS

JURISDICTION: The Show will be held under the licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force on the 1st July 2018

REGISTRATION etc. All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club, Unit 36 Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6W.

VENUE: The Show will be held at **The Amber Springs, Wexford Road, Gorey, Co. Wexford.** On the 15th July 2018.

ENTRIES: The service charge will be based on the following scales:-

First entry of first dog €25.00. Each additional entry (for same or different dog) is €10.00. "CAR PARK FREE" Catalogue €3.00 (not included in entry fee)

Enter any number of dogs in same ownership for €50.00

Entries:-will be received up to and including 22nd June 2018 by the Show Secretary.

ENTRY FORMS (mistakes in): The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by exhibitors and while every endeavour will be made to have forms correctly interpreted the St. Bernard Club of Ireland cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring exhibitors within the purview of Irish Kennel Club Rule 15, Section 1, or for clerical mistakes that may occur during compilation.

VETERINARY EXAMINATION: The Veterinary Surgeon on call will have the power to exclude any exhibit which in his opinion .is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of Disease, lice or other cause.

Judges: In the event of any appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.

JUDGING:

Judging will commence at 1.00pm. Short Hair St. Bernard's will be judged first in the morning. Followed by Best Short Hair. The Long Hair St. Bernard's will be judged after a short break, Followed by Best Long Hair. Variety classes including Junior handling will then commence.

No person will be allowed in the Judging ring except the Judge ,Show Officials, or an Exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.

The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring.

The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring. In the event of an exhibitor requesting a steward or other official to handle his or her exhibit in the ring, and such official may do so only in the understanding that such action is on behalf of the exhibitor and does not involve any responsibility whatsoever on the Club for loss or damage consequential or otherwise.

Responsibility:- exhibitors will please understand that while every possible precaution will be taken to ensure safety of the exhibits, the Committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained by any exhibitor through accident or otherwise.

ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE: The Committee will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to any exhibitor or other person attending the show

Visitors are requested not to handle the dogs on exhibition.

ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS appearing in the Evening Herald; prior to the date of closing of entries and in reference to any alterations made by the committee in the schedule or in these regulations .shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.

Interpretation: The Committee of the St. Bernard Club of Ireland shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. rules, and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd..
