SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1) **Jurisdiction:** The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., as in force on the 14th August 2010
- 2) **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., Unit 36 Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6.
- 3) **Venue:** The Show will be held in the The National Show Centre, Cloghran , Swords, Co. Dublin on Saturday 14th August 2010.
- 4) **Entries:** A Service Charge of €20 for the first dog. €25.00 any number of dogs from the same owner.

Fees of exhibits arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited.

No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

Entries will be received up to and including 14th July 2010 (post marked) by the Secretary. Morag Connolly, Drogheda Road, Togher, Drogheda, Co. Louth. Ireland.

The promoting body reserves the right to refuse any entry, advertisements or other insertion in the Catalogue.

The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every effort will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the Weimaraner Club of Ireland cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., Rule 15, Section 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.

A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging but in no other respects.

- 5) **Fees:** As there are no Entry Fee charges, no Prize Money will be given. Rosettes will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Reserve in each Class. Rosettes will also be given to Green Star Bitch, Green Star Dog, Reserve Green Star Bitch, Reserve Green Star Dog, Best in Show, Reserve Best in Show and Best Puppy in Show
- 6) **Exhibits:** Each owner or agent shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times and ensure their exhibits are removed not later than 7.00pm.
- 7) **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.

- 8) Judging:** Will commence at 11.00 am sharp. No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the Ring.
- 9) Announcements:** Exhibitors will be notified of any alterations made by the Club in the Schedule or in these Regulations by prior notice of the Show Secretary and shall be deemed sufficient notice there of.
- 10) Interpretation:** The Committee of the Promoting Club shall be the "Show Committee" within the meaning of the I.K.C. Rules, all disputes, if any, shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club.
- 11) Accident or Damage:** The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the Show.
- Note:** All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor

RULES FOR JUDGING

- Rule 1* The Weimaraner Club of Ireland will not accept any responsibility, nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Classes or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to commence. The promoting body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Class, or for Best in Show, owing to the judging of its breeds not having been completed, or for any other reason.
- Rule 2* Competition for Green Star will be confined to undefeated winners.
- Rule 3* No dog shall be entitled to compete for the Green Star where any prize or award has been withheld from it at the show.
- Rule 4* In each Class and Best in Show the Judges shall make the following awards: 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th. Absentees must be marked
- Rule 5* Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show will be confined to Best Dog and Best Bitch.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES AT BREED CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

(All age classes computed from date of birth.)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

Minor Puppy Class is confined to puppies of six months and under nine months of age on the first day of the show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. (.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.***

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth..

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

Dogs entered in restricted classes must also be entered in one of the Standard Classes for the breed. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

NOTE: Addition to I.K.C. Rule 7, Section 1

Every dog exhibited, or competing at any show, Field Trial or Obedience Test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. in the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club and dogs not of a recognised breed for which a licence has been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working Tests.

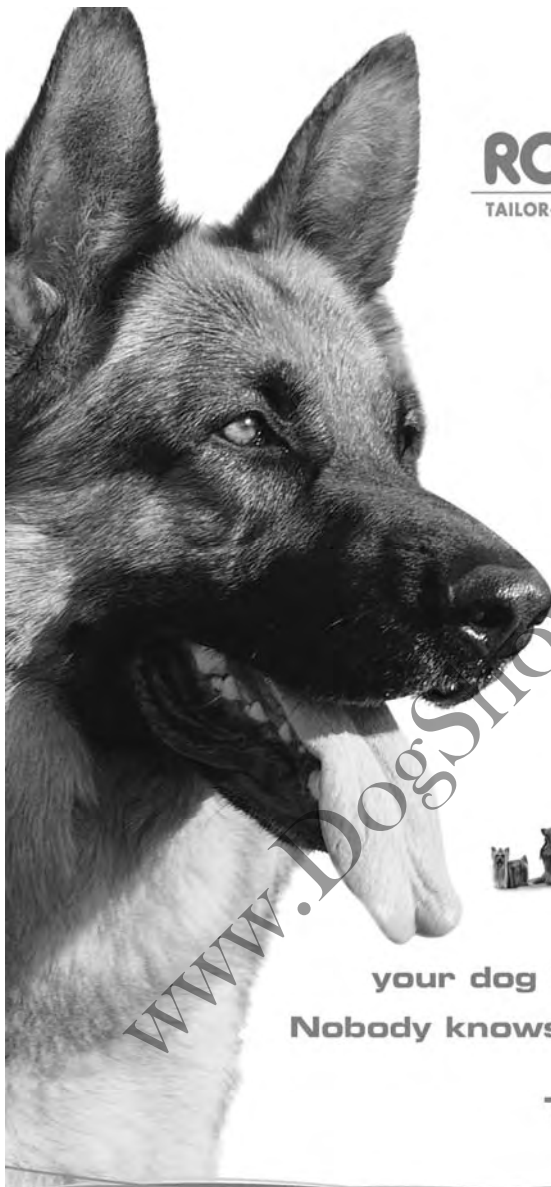
Failure to comply with the above will result in:

- a)** the dog being disqualified from the event and
- b)** the exhibitor being fined €127.00

The implementation of which shall be a Normal (I.K.C) Office Routine.

All appeals to the Irish Kennel Club will carry the appropriate fee refundable if the appeal is upheld.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW, AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION ON THE ENTRY FORM.
