SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1) **Jurisdiction:** The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- 2) **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- 3) **Venue:** The Show will be held at the grounds of Fitzgeralds Woodlands House Hotel, Knockanes, Adare, Co. Limerick **23rd of August 2018**.
- 4) **Entries:** A Service Charge of €22 or £22.00 for the first dog irrespective of the number of Classes in which the dog is entered and €8.00 or £8.00 for each additional entry or €35.00 or £35.00 any number of dogs from the same owner.
Special classes are free but dogs must have been entered in some other class.
Fees of exhibits arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited.
No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.
Postal entries will be received up to and including 27th July 2018 (post marked) by the Secretary – Katarzyna Rzyman, Misty Meadows, Ballynadrishoge, Blackwater, Enniscorthy, Co. Wexford
Online entries up to and including 3rd of August 2018 – dogshowentry.ie
The promoting body reserves the right to refuse any entry, advertisements or other insertion in the Catalogue.
The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every effort will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the Weimaraner Club of Ireland cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., Rule 15, Section 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
A transfer of an incorrect entry as to the sex is allowed if reported to the Secretary's office prior to the commencing of judging. A dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the Open Class in the Breed, but in no other respects.
- 5) **Awards:** No Prize Money will be given. Ribbons will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places in each Class. Rosettes will also be given to Green Star Bitch, Green Star Dog, Reserve Green Star Bitch, Reserve Green Star Dog, Best in Show, Reserve Best in Show and Best Baby Puppy in Show.
- 6) **Exhibits:** Each owner or agent shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times and ensure their exhibits are removed not later than 7.00pm.
- 7) **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
- 8) **Judging:** Will commence at as soon as the ring has been vacated by dogs entered in the Limerick All Breed Championship Show but not sooner than 14.00pm. No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the Ring.
- 9) **Announcements:** Exhibitors will be notified of any alterations made by the Club in the Schedule or in these Regulations by prior notice of the Show Secretary and shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
- 10) **Interpretation:** The Committee of the Promoting Club shall be the "Show Commit-

tee” within the meaning of the I.K.C. Rules, all disputes, if any, shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club.

11) Accident or Damage: The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the Show.

Note: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds unless they are entered in Baby Puppy Class. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor

NOTE: New Addition to I.K.C. Rule 7, Section 1

Every dog exhibited, or competing at any show, Field Trial or Obedience Test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. in the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club and dogs not of a recognised breed for which a licence has been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working Tests.

Failure to comply with the above will result in:

- a)** the dog being disqualified from the event and
- b)** the exhibitor being fined €130.00

The implementation of which shall be a Normal (I.K.C) Office Routine.

All appeals to the Irish Kennel Club will carry the appropriate fee refundable if the appeal is upheld.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW, AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION ON THE ENTRY FORM.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

A Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may only compete for Best Baby Puppy in Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to the dogs over 6 and under 12 calendar months of age on the first day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the show computed, from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champion Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.***

*** A Veteran dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

A Veteran Class is for dogs over 8 years of age on the first day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Field Trial Class is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stake.

Brace Class for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some other class.

Breeder's group consisting of minimum three and maximum five exhibits of the same breed and variety, no matter what gender, bred by the same person (same kennel name), even if they are not his/her property.

Working Class is confined to dogs who work Obedience or Working Trials.

RULES FOR JUDGING

Rule 1 The Weimaraner Club of Ireland will not accept any responsibility, nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Classes or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to commence. The promoting body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Class, or for Best in Show, owing to the judging of its breeds not having been completed, or for any other reason.

Rule 2 There will be 2 sets of Green Stars, one for Longhair Weimaraners and one for Shorthair Weimaraners. Competition for Green Star will be confined to undefeated winners.

Rule 3 No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Class where any prize or award has been withheld from it at the show.

Rule 4 In each Class and Best in Show the Judges shall make the following awards: 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th. Absentees must be marked

Rule 5 Best in Show will be confined to Best of Breed winners. Reserve Best in Show confined to Best of Breed winner and Reserve Best of Breed winner to Best in Show winner.
