SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **JURISDICTION**: The Show will be held under the licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. and a copy of the Rules will be posted in the office of the Secretary on the day of the show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.

VENUE & Date: The Show will be held at Naas Racecourse Naas, Co. Kildare.

W91 ED00 on Sunday 20th April 2025.

3. ENTRY FEES: The entry fee will be based on the following scale:Dogs registered in partnerships or joint owners are treated as separate entries even when forwarded by single owners.

Breed Classes €26.00 for 1st dog

Additional Dogs €16.00 each. (Same ownership)

Neuter Class: €16.00 per dog Baby Puppy: €10.00 per dog

Fees of exhibitors arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge., which cannot be refunded under any circumstances. Entries will be received up to and including the 9th AprilMay 2025 (postmark) by the Show Secretary: Hon. Secretary Mrs M Weafer, 167 The Park, Naas, Co Kildare, Ph 0851117408. Online closes on the 11thApril 2025. www.dogshowentry.ie.

- a) ENTRY FORMS (mistakes in): The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by exhibitors and while every endeavour will be made to have forms correctly interpreted. the Akita Association of Ireland cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring exhibitors within the purview of Irish Kennel Club Rule 15, Section 1, or for clerical mistakes that may occur during compilation.
- b) REJECTING ENTRIES etc.: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry. advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue or allocation of stand space at the show. INELIGIBLE ENTRIES: A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in an age class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class.
- 4. REGISTRATION etc. All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club, Unit 36 Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6W. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
- 5. Prizes: Prize cards will be given to 1st 2nd 3rd and reserve in each class.
- 6. VETERINARY EXAMINATION: The Veterinary Surgeon on call will have the power to exclude any exhibit which in his opinion is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of Disease, lice or other cause.
- 7. **EXHIBITS:** Each exhibitor shall be responsible to keep their exhibits under proper control at all times. Every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later than a half hour after completion of the judging of Best in Show.
- 9. Judges: In the event of any appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges. The right is reserved to the Show Committee to change a judge in a breed or breeds, or part of a breed, if it is considered such a change is in the best interest of the show

10. JUDGING: .

- a) No person will be allowed in the Judging ring except the Judge ,Show Officials, or an Exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.
- b) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring.

- The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring at the time of judging.
- 11. Judges Decision: The decision of a judge at the termination of his or her judging a class shall be final, except in the case of an objection properly made and upheld under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., where a judge states that a clerical or other mistake was made in an award as Officially returned, or on the ground of fraud.
- **12. Protest:** all protests and objections must be made in the manner specified in Irish Kennel Club Ltd. Rules 13, 15, 17.
- 13. Interpretation: The Committee of the Promoting Club shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. rules, and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd..
- **14. ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE**: The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
- 15. ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS appearing in the Daily Newspaper or other publication, in reference to any alterations made by the Committee in the schedule or in these regulations .shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.

CLASS DEFINITIONS FOR NATIONAL SHOWS Held under Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award other than Best Baby Puppy in Breed/Show

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve months of age on the day of the Show.

A Junior Class is for dogs between nine and eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show.

Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under the rules and regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show ** Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in <u>ONE BREED CLASS ONLY</u> (No double entries)

Neuter Class:

The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.
