## **Breed Championship Show Regulations**

- 1. **The show** will be held under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club as in force on the day of publication of the schedule and every exhibitor is deemed aware of these rules.
- Prizes: Rosettes in all classes for 1st to 4th places in all classes. Club cups and special prizes on offer to all members of The American Cocker Spaniel Club of Ireland.
- 3. Entry fee: €25 for the first dog, €10 for subsequent dogs,
- 4. **In the event** of the appointed judge failing to keep his/her engagement, the committee shall have the right to appoint a substitute judge.
- 5. **The American Cocker Spaniel Club** of Ireland shall not be responsible for any loss or damage through accident or otherwise sustained by exhibitors or other persons attending the show, or the exhibits.
- 6. **All dogs** must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Limited.
- 7. **The American Cocker Spaniel Club** of Ireland shall not be responsible for any mistake in the catalogue, which may bring the exhibitor within the purview of the IKC. In the event of mistakes or omissions in the catalogue the exhibitor should immediately inform the ring steward and report the inaccuracy to the secretary.
- 8. **Winners** of the variety classes can not compete for a green star.
- 9. **Please note:** In accordance with the new IKC regulations now in force a dog or bitch may be entered in one breed class only (i.e. no double entries).

## **CLASS DEFINITIONS**

#### Baby Puppy

Class is confined to dogs over four and under six months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition

#### Puppy

Class is confined to dogs over 6 and under 12 months of age on the day of the Show

#### Junior

Class is confined to dogs over 9 and under 18 months of age on the day of the Show.

#### Intermediate

Class is confined to dogs over 15 and under 24 months on the day of the Show.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Open

Class is confined to dog over 15 months on the day of the Show.

#### Champion

Class is confined to dogs that have attained the title of Champion under the Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or other Kennel Authority recognised by the Irish Kennel Club.

#### Veteran

Class is confined to dog over 8 years of age on the day of the Show \* A Veteran dog who has attained the title of Champion, may enter the Veteran or Champion Class but not both,

**Field Trial Class** is confined to dogs who have won at least a reserve in a Puppy, Novice, Derby or Open Stake as defined in the Field Trial Rules & Regulations.

# Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.\*\*

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

**Restricted / Special Classes** (i.e. Colour Classes etc) The dog must be entered in one of the standard classes scheduled for the breed, as above.
