1. **Jurisdiction:** The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., as in force on the 1st January 2024
2. **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Fottrell House, Harold's Cross Bridge, Dublin 6
Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
3. **Venue-** The Show will be held at Ulster Flying Club, Newtownards Airport, 61 Portaferry Road, NEWTOWNARDS, Co Down, BT23 8SG. **SUNDAY 23rd June 2024**

7. **Rejection of Entries, etc.** -The promoting body reserves the right to refuse any entry , advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue or the allocation of Stand space at the Show.
8. **ENTRY FORMS:** The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the Bangor & North Down Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
9. **Ineligible Entries:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in an age class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class, but in no other respects. there will be Prize Money. Prize cards will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Reserve in each Class. Rosettes will be given to Green Star Winners, Best of Breed, Best A.V.N.S.C., Group Winners to 4th. place. Best in Show and Reserve Best in show. Special Prizes offered for competition by or through a Specialist Club shall be collected and distributed by that Club.
10. **Exhibits:** (a) Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times; (b) every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later than 7.00 pm.
11. **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement or should his or her entries exceed 150 dogs, the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
12. **Judging:** (a) Breed Judging will commence at **9.30 a.m. sharp, Junior Handling at 9.00am.** No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late, (b) No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. (c) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler. who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. (d) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring.
13. **Special Prizes** offered by a Special Club must be collected from the Club.
14. **All announcements** appearing in the “Dog Press” prior to the closing of entries or in reference to any alterations made by the club in the Schedule or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
15. **Interpretation.** The Committee of the Promoting Club shall be the “Show Committee” within the meaning of the I.K.C. Rules; all disputes, if any, shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
16. **Accident or Damage.** The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
17. **Exercise/Puppy Pens:** are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, **at all shows** licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.
19. **Dogs not entered for competition:** Dogs which are not being exhibited at all Breed Championship Shows must be entered as **NOT FOR COMPETITION**, for insurance purposes, prior to close of entries. Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of breed/s and name/s of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs and keep a record of same. Production of passes may be requested in any area of dispute. The fee for this facility shall be **Five Euro, (€5.00), per dog.**
20. **Puppies under** the age of six (6) months **should not** be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Notice for schedule

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified) (effective from the 1st January 2011)

Breeds Not Separately Listed

Breeds entered in the Breeds Not Separately Listed at National Championship Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the Catalogue. A Judge may award a Green Star and Best of Breed in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded excellent or in the case of puppies "Very Promising" Effective from 1st January 2011.

Cropped Dogs

Cropped dogs are not permitted to be exhibited at any Irish Kennel Club licenced event.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.******

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

Neuter Class: Neutered Male and Neutered Female are confined to this class can compete for Best Neuter In Breed and go forward to Best Neuter In Show (they may not compete for the Green Star)

FIELD TRIAL CLASS is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stake.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

Special Beginners Stakes

A new stakes class to help promote newcomers to the scene and also to encourage some competing in the more numerically strong breeds. To be eligible to compete, neither the owner/handler or the dog will have won a Green Star prior to the entry closing date of the show. This class can be offered at any show. This is judged on the quality of the dog and placings are 1-4 as in the other stakes classes. The organising Show Society decide the prizes they wish to offer (and if they want to charge an entry fee. In the event that a dog is co-owned, all owners must fulfil the criteria).

OBEDIENCE CLASS DEFINITIONS

Under General Rules

Food or any other article may not be given or carried in the ring, with the exception of Pre-Beginners and Beginners where a non-squeaky/non-audible toy may be carried by the handler.

PRE -BEGINNERS OBEDIENCE CLASS

Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded **three** first prizes (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Limited Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club Limited.

Handlers may carry a non-squeaky/audible toy in their hand or pocket and reward the dog by playing with that toy for up to 20 seconds at the end of each exercise with the exception of the stay test. The dog is not allowed to play with the toy during the exercise.

BEGINNERS OBEDIENCE CLASS

Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or awarded **four** or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks)) in any obedience test, other than Pre-Beginners Obedience Class, under Irish Kennel Club Limited Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club Limited.

Handlers may carry a non-squeaky/non-audible toy in their hand or pocket and reward the dog by playing with that toy for up to 20 seconds at the end of each exercise with the exception of the stay test. The dog is not allowed to play with the toy during the exercise.

NOVICE OBEDIENCE CLASS

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience class other than in Beginners Obedience class.

CLASS A OBEDIENCE

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience Class other than in Beginners and Novice Obedience classes.

CLASS B OBEDIENCE

Old Rule:- Down five (5) minutes (30 points). Handler out of sight.

New Rule:- Down four (4) minutes (30 points). Handler out of sight.

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded a Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience Classes with the exception of Beginners, Novice or Class A Obedience.

OPEN CLASS C OBEDIENCE / CH. CLASS C OBEDIENCE

Open to all.

INTRODUCING OUR OVERSEAS JUDGES

MARIANO DI CHICCO (ITALY) Since 2007 he has been FCI Judge for All Group 2,4,5 and 10; but he Judge also some breeds of Group 1,3,8,9. He started his dog career as a breeder of Cane Corso. In 1998 he was the first breeder in the history of this breed to obtain the FCI Kennel name, with the designation "Della Porta Dipinta ". He has won several World Championships, European Championships, International Championships and many Italian titles, has written two books on his breed.He was also the first breeder of Cane Corso to become a judge in 2007. He judged Specialty all over the World for the Cane Corso, from the United States of America to Russia, passing through all the major European countries. He then became a specialist also of the molosser and after of the Bull Type Terriers. In 2015 he was chosen in the jury of the World Championship and in 2016 of the European Championship. We welcome Mariano to Ireland for the first time and delighted for him to judge Best in Show.

JADRANKA MIJATOVIA (CROATIA) My first pure bred dog was a Dalmatian female and then later I was introduced to an already very successful Rough Collie breeder and pretty soon I was the new owner a Rough Collie female and co-owner of a male. The breeder in question was Denis Sabolic (DENNISAY'S Collies), who later became my mentor, my friend and my partner. We continue breeding our Dennisay's-Geantles Collies and have bred or owned over 100 Champions Together with Denis, we were the first handlers in the country and were part of a small international group of 4 professional handlers. I was one of the founders of the British Sheepdog Club Zagreb and a member of the Board for 5 years & President of the Breeding Committee. Today I am in the Board of our local KC near Zagreb, where we live now. Over the years I have been involved in organization of a couple of National and International shows with great success. Currently I am a Chairwoman of a Double International Ch. show known as 4 RIVERS WINNER in Karlovac. Both Denis and I are holders of the GOLDEN MEDAL, one of the highest awards given by the Croatian Kennel Club for our breeding & showing achievements and also for our overall contribution to Croatian cynology. I became a dog show judge in 1993. My first licensed breeds were British Sheepdogs. 10 years later I have finished the FCI Group I and FCI Group V. Today I am International FCI judge for FCI Group I, III, IV, V, VIII (Retrievers & Am. & English Cockers), IX and X with some additional breeds in the group II, and VI. During these 24 years I have judged in over 25 countries, 4 Continents, including the Collie National in Melbourne, Australia, which was a great honor for me as a breeder. Photography is my another passion and four years ago we celebrated 20 years of DEYA PHOTOGRAPHY which is a name renowned throughout the world. We welcome Jadranka to Ireland.

INGE ARTSOE (DENMARK) a highly respected Danish breeder, made significant contributions to the world of Newfoundlands. Having breed the UK record holder of all time Newhouse Scandinavian Warrior owned by Merrybear Kennels. We welcome Inge to her first ever visit to Ireland.

BRUNO NODALLI (ITALY) & VIVIANA NODALLI (ITALY) Bruno breeds poodles of medium size and toy since 1982 with my wife Paola and my daughter Viviana, since 1990 with the prefix "Osmanthus". Since I was a child dogs have always been part of my life and the passion for this breed has involved most of my free time without neglecting my small company in which, since 1977 we have been dealing with the construction of electronic equipment for industrial and civil automation. Retired at the end of 2014, I can spend more time with my passion for dogs and the dog world.

During these 37 years, I had the luck to meet the most important historical breeders and Expert Judges of the Dog World. All this has increased my passion, my cultural baggage and of which, I cherish their teachings with esteem and affection. In October 2006 I became a Poodle Expert judge and later on an International FCI Judge. I am currently qualified for all FCI breeds of groups 2, 5, 9,10 and some breeds of group 1. I am a trainee Expert Judge for the poodle breed in Italy and in France, in which, I am qualified for the Confirmation as well. In these thirteen years, I had the honor to judge the 2013 and 2019 European shows, the 2015 World show, the most important International shows and specialties in whole Europe, Israel, Scandinavia , Canada, Russia and Japan. I have written historical articles and comments for the KC and various specialized magazines.

CORNELIA BERGUNDTHAL (SWITZERLAND) Cornelia was born in the German-speaking part of Switzerland and, since 2013, is living most of the time in France. Dogs of different breeds accompanied her life since childhood. She bought her first Staffordshire Bull Terrier in 1990. Since 1992 and till now, she breeds Staffordshire Bull Terrier under the affix "BUT'S CHARMING RUFFIANS" (BCR). She has also successfully bred American Staffordshire Terrier and Manchester Terrier until 2006. Many national, international, 1 World Winner and 1 European Winner and (for the moment) 1 UK champion are born under her affix. She is also very proud of all the great family dogs, Agility and Therapy dogs she has bred over the last 30 years. She is a licensed FCI-judge since 2000 for American Staffordshire Terrier. Since 2005, she judged several other Terrier breeds and, since 2010 Cornelia is allowed to judge the complete Terrier group under the rules of the FCI.

Since 1994, she is the chairwomen of the American Staffordshire Terrier Club of Switzerland and a member of Bull Breed Clubs in Germany and France. Since 2016 she is a member of the UK Kennel Club. She has judged on national and international all breed shows and national specialties in: Switzerland, Germany, France, Italy, Finland, Russia, Luxemburg, Slovenia, Czech Republic, Poland, Ireland, United Kingdom, Australia. Cornelia speaks German, French and English. We welcome Cornelia on her first appointment in N.Ireland

AKE CRONANDER (SWEDEN) Ake's journey as a judge began in 1995 when he was first licensed to judge Dalmatians, Whippets, and other sighthound breeds. Since then, he has expanded his repertoire to include more breeds and groups. Notably, his most famous dog is the Whippet named "Int. NordFinPortAust Ch SV-91-92 EUW-94 Airescot Waistcoat.": Ake has officiated dog shows in various countries, including Australia, Belgium, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Cyprus, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Lithuania, Macedonia, Netherlands, Norway, Russia, Slovenia, and Sweden.

ANDREW BRACE (UK) Andrew Brace is a prominent figure in the world of purebred dogs. His passion for canines has led him to wear multiple hats, including breeder, judge, and author. Let's delve into his fascinating journey: Breeder and Boxer Enthusiast He acquired his first Boxer in 1963 and became deeply involved in the breed. His expertise spans approximately 80 breeds across all seven groups recognized by the Kennel Club. He is authorized to award Challenge Certificates (C.Cs.) in various breeds, including those from the Hound, Working, Pastoral, Utility, and Toy Groups. Andrew has graced prestigious events like Crufts and even judged several breeds at the Westminster Kennel Club show in the USA. Andrew shares his wealth of knowledge through writing. His contributions to the international purebred dog community extend beyond the show circuit. We welcome Andrew to Northern Ireland.

JOHN J WALSH We are delighted to have John judging our Best Irish Native Breeds today.

The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; Great Japanese Dog and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (**Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed)**)

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas; three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

Videos

It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.

Failure to comply with the above will result in: (A) The dog being disqualified from the event and (B) the exhibitor being fined €127.00.
