- Registrations: All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Fottrell House, Harold's Cross Bridge, Dublin 6
   Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted with- out further registration.
- Venue- The Show will be held at Ulster Flying Club, Newtownards Airport, 61 Portaferry Road, NEWTOWNARDS, ,Co Down, BT23 8SG on the 14th June 2025

- 7. **Rejection of Entries, etc.** -The promoting body reserves the right to refuse any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue or the allocation of Stand space at the Show.
- 8. ENTRY FORMS: The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the Banbridge & District Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
- 9. Ineligible Entries: A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in an age class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class, but in no other respects There will be Prize Money. Prize cards will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Reserve in each Class. Rosettes will be given to Green Star Winners, Best of Breed, Best A.V.N.S.C., Group Winners to 4th. place. Best in Show and Reserve Best in show. Special Prizes offered for competition by or through a Specialist Club shall be collected and distributed by that Club.
- **10. Exhibits:** (a) Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times; (b) every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later than 7.00 pm.
- **11. Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement or should his or her entries exceed 150 dogs, the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
- 12. Judging: (a) Will commence at 8.30 a.m. sharp, Junior Handling. 9.00am No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late, (b) No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. (c) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler. who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. (d) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring.
- 13. Special Prizes offered by a Special Club must be collected from the Club.
- 14. All announcements appearing in the "Dog Press" prior to the closing of entries or in reference to any alterations made by the club in the Schedule or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
- **15. Interpretation.** The Committee of the Promoting Club shall be the "Show Committee" within the meaning of the I.K.C. Rules; all disputes, if any, shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- **16. Accident or Damage.** The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
- 18. Exercise/Puppy Pens: are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, <u>at all shows</u> licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.
- 19. **Dogs not entered for competition:** Dogs which are not being exhibited at all Breed Championship Shows must be entered as **NOT FOR COMPETITION**, for insurance purposes, prior to close of entries. Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of breed/s and name/s of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs and keep a record of same. Production of passes may be requested in any area of dispute. The fee for this facility shall be **Five Euro**, (€5.00), **per dog**.
- **20.** Puppies under the age of six (6) months should not be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.

#### NOTE Addition to I.K.C. Rule 7 Section 1.

Every dog exhibited, or competing at any Show, Field Trial or Obedience Test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. In the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club, and dogs not of a recognised breed for which licences have been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working Test. Failure to comply with the above will result in: (A) The dog being disqualified from the event and (B) the exhibitor being fined €127.00.

The implementation of this will be a normal (I.K.C.) Office routine.

#### RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

- 1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
- 2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
- No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
- 4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
- Groups will be divided into ten sections as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
- 6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
- In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3<sup>rd</sup> etc. to 4<sup>th</sup> place, absentees MUST be marked.
- Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
- 9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

#### Notice for schedule

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified) (effective from the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2011)

# **Breeds Not Separately Listed**

Breeds entered in the Breeds Not Separately Listed at National Championship Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the Catalogue. A Judge may award a Green Star and Best of Breed in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded excellent or in the case of puppies "Very Promising" Effective from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2011.

# **Cropped Dogs**

Cropped dogs are not permitted to be exhibited at any Irish Kennel Club licenced event.

#### CLASS DEFINITIONS INTERNATIONAL SHOWS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

A Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under nine months of age on the day of the Show.

#### (Puppies may not compete for the Green Star or CACIB)

A Junior Class is for dogs over nine and under eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. (Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to compete for the CACIB but may compete for the Green Star)

**An Intermediate Class** is for dogs over 15 and under 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

**Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show.

**Champions Class** is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club rules or under another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show (Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to compete for the CACIB)

\* Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.\*

Working Class To enter a dog in working class, the entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the FCI compulsory certificate containing the confirmation -by the member country in which the holder and/or owner has his permanent place of residence- that the dog has passed the test as well as details about this test. The only breeds eligible for the working class are those appearing as working breeds in the FCI Breed Nomenclature, taking into account the exceptions granted to some countries for some breeds.

Neuter Class: Neutered Male and Neutered Female are confined to this class can compete for Best Neuter In Breed and go forward to Best Neuter In Show (they may not compete for the Green Star)

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in <u>ONE BREED CLASS ONLY</u> (No double entries)

The decisive date in respect of age is the day the dog is shown.

# OBEDIENCE CLASS DEFINITIONS IRISH KENNEL CLUB - OBEDIENCE Class Definitions:

### Pre-Beginners Obedience

Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded four first prizes (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club CLG., Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club CLG.

#### **Beginners Obedience**

Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or awarded four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test, other than Pre-Beginners Obedience Class, under Irish Kennel Club CLG., Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club CLG.

#### **Novice Obedience**

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club CLG., regulations) in any Obedience class other than in Beginners Obedience class.

#### Class A Obedience

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club CLG., regulations) in any Obedience Class other than in Beginners and Novice Obedience classes.

#### Class B Obedience

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded a Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club CLG., regulations) in any Obedience Classes with the exception of Beginners, Novice or Class A Obedience.

Ch. Class C Obedience is open to all.

#### **EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE**

#### The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; Great Japanese Dog and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed)

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas; three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

#### Videos

It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.

#### NOTE Addition to I.K.C. Rule 7 Section 1.

Every dog exhibited, or competing at any Show, Field Trial or Obedience Test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. In the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club, and dogs not of a recognised breed for which licences have been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working Test.

Failure to comply with the above will result in: (A) The dog being disqualified from the event and (B) the exhibitor being fined €127.00.

The implementation of this will be a normal (I.K.C.) Office routine.

### **DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW**

#### FROM DUBLIN

Take M1—Signs Belfast/The North (A1) N1 at Sprucefield roundabout take 2nd exit onto M1 sliproad— The North/Belfast (M1) continue on towards Belfast. Leave M1 continues onto A12 (Westlink) Take exit marked M3 City Airport/Bangor. Going past City Airport stay right hand lane. At large intersection (lights) follow signs A55—Outer Ring/Newcastle/Lisburn, proceed then to follow signs for A20 Newtownards. Coming into Newtownards Town at bottom of carriageway take 3rd exit continue to small roundabout straight over (2nd exit) Comber/Portaferry, at end of road take 2nd exit Portaferry/Bangor, go past Tesco shopping centre at roundabout at end of road take 2nd exit (A20) Portaferry. Continue past Texaco garage on right hand side and venue is next on right hand side.

# FROM BELFAST (City Airport)

Going past George Best Airport keep left towards Bangor on A2, continue approx. 8 miles. On carriageway coming towards Bangor you will see turn off for Newtownards/Blackwood golf...DONT take this one.. You will see road opening into 2 lanes plus slip road on right, get into right hand lane. Turn down road signposted Rathgael, follow road to end, at roundabout take 3rd exit—Newtownards A20 continue into Newtownards, straight over 2 roundabouts heading to Comber/Portaferry (A20) Keep left, at T junction turn left Portaferry/Greyabbey/Kircubbin (A20) past Texaco Garage and venue is next on right.


#### FROM COMBER
