Introducing our Judge Ms. Lorraine Watkins – Shipshape - UK

My family owned and bred bulldogs from 1938. In 1972 my parents bought a pug for me to show. In 1975 my grandparents bought a bulldog for me to show. I continued showing and handling and then exhibited, bred and judged Newfoundland's from 1984.

I have been involved with bulldogs more seriously since 2005. I have owned or bred 2 UK champions, bred an international champion in Europe and bred two champions in Hong Kong.

I judged Canine societies from 2009, breed club open shows from 2012. In August 2019 I was accepted onto the A2 list to award CCs in bulldogs, having been assessed by 3 championship judges.

I have judged in the UK, Italy, Holland and the Czech Republic. I was a breed club secretary for 11 years. I am the Kennel Clubs Breed Education Coordinator, organising all the judges training for any person wanting to judge bulldogs in the UK. In 2022 I took the position of Secretary of the Bulldog Breed Council.

My life revolves around Bulldogs, and I am honoured to be judging your show and look forward to seeing your dog's soon.

This is Lorraine's first time to judge in Ireland, so let's give her a big welcome with a super entry.

Show Rules, Regulations and Instructions to Exhibitors

1. The Show will be held under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
2. Venue - The Show will be held at The National Show Centre, Cloghran, on Saturday, 13th May 2023
3. Entry Fee - **1st Dog €25.00 Euro .N.B. A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries), and €8.00 for each additional dog in the same ownership. Neuter Class €7.00 per dog. Baby Puppy if only dog entered €7.00**
Catalogue : €3.00.
4. Entries - will be received up to **28th April 2023 (Postmark).**
Enter online at www.dogshowentry.ie. Entries online close at midnight on the 5th May 2023
5. Entry Forms: Mistakes - The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted, The Bulldog Club of Ireland cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of The Irish Kennel Club Ltd. Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
6. Rejection of Entries: The committee reserve the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue.
7. Ineligible Entries: A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging but in no other respects.
8. Registrations: All dogs entered for competition at this Show must be registered with The Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
9. Prizes - The Bulldog Club of Ireland, **Club Trophies for photographs only – no trophies will be allowed to be taken home with exhibitors**
10. Prizes Withheld: A Judge shall be empowered to withhold any prize, prizes or Green Stars if in his or her opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
11. During the exhibition of dogs, the judge officiating will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
12. Exhibits Not Sent: Persons entering an exhibit or exhibits and failing to send them for exhibition or should their exhibit be rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon, will forfeit the entrance fees paid.
13. While efforts will be made by Stewards to see that every eligible dog present at the Show will be brought into the Ring when required for judging, The Bulldog Club of Ireland cannot accept any responsibility for the absence of any dog when the judging of a Class or Group is about to commence.
14. Veterinary Examination: Any Veterinary Surgeon acting with the authority of the Show Committee may have any dog removed from the show if: (1) suspected cause of infection or contagious disease; (2) totally blind or deaf; (3) vicious or savage disposition.
15. Judges: In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his/her engagement the Committee shall have the right to fill the vacancy thus caused.
16. Judging - will commence after Hibernian breed judging, when ring is available, and no claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking

17. Interpretation: The Guarantors of The Bulldog Club of Ireland shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the I.K.C. Ltd. Rules and all disputes, if any, shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any disputes shall have the right to appeal to The I.K.C. Ltd.
18. The Show will be open to the public from 10.00 a.m. to 15.00 p.m.
19. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
20. Each Exhibitor shall, be responsible for keeping their exhibit under control at all times. No Dogs shall be left shut in cars; and if left in trailers or boxes must be kept under constant supervision.
21. All Exhibitors are required to bring a scooper and plastic bag etc., to remove any fouling made by their dogs and any other litter on any part of the show ground.
22. The Promoting body will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.

Note Addition To I.K.C. Rule 131

Re: Registration of Dogs Entered

Addition to the above Rule:

Failure to comply with the above will result in:

(A) The Dog being disqualified from the event and

(B) The exhibitor being fined E130 Euro.

The implementation of which shall be Normal (I.K.C.) Office routine.

Class Definitions: (The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Veteran is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show.

Baby Puppy is confined to dogs over 4 and under 6 calendar months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition.

Puppy is confined to dogs over 6 and under 12 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

Junior is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

Intermediate is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Open is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show.

Champion is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.****

Neuter Class; The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.
