BANGOR AND NORTH DOWN CANINE CLUB SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **Jurisdiction:** The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., as in force on the 3RD September 2022
2. **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Fottrell House, Harold's Cross Bridge, Dublin 6
 Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
3. **Venue-** The Show will be held at Ulster Flying Club, Newtownards Airport, 61 Portaferry Road , Newtownards, Co Down, BT23 8SG
Catalogues: a limited number will be on sale within the grounds, price €6 (£5) and can also be prepaid with entry price €5(£4).
Car Park: €5 (£5) prepaid with entries or €8 (£8) on day.
We advise prepaid car park to avoid congestion on entry to venue.
CAMPING: Overnight camping is available for €15/(£15) but MUST be prepaid with entries with vehicle registration provided.
4. **ENTRIES: Entry fees will be based on the following scale**
5. **No entries** will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

7. **Rejection of Entries, etc.** -The promoting body reserves the right to refuse any entry , advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue or the allocation of Stand space at the Show.

8. **ENTRY FORMS:** The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the Bangor & North Down Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
9. **Ineligible Entries:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in an age class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class, but in no other respects.
10. **As there** are no Entry Fees charged, there will be no Prize Money. Prize cards will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Reserve in each Class. Rosettes will be given to Green Star Winners, Best of Breed, Best A.V.N.S.C., Group Winners to 4th. place. Best in Show and Reserve Best in show. Special Prizes offered for competition by or through a Specialist Club shall be collected and distributed by that Club.
11. **Exhibits:** (a) Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times; (b) every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later than 7.00 pm.
12. **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement or should his or her entries exceed 130 dogs, the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
13. **Judging:** (a) Will commence at **10.00 a.m. sharp, including Junior Handling.** No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late, (b) No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. (c) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler. who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. (d) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring.
14. **Special Prizes** offered by a Special Club must be collected from the Club.
15. **All announcements** appearing in the “Dog Press” prior to the closing of entries or in reference to any alterations made by the club in the Schedule or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
16. **Interpretation.** The Committee of the Promoting Club shall be the “Show Committee” within the meaning of the I.K.C. Rules; all disputes, if any, shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
17. **Accident or Damage.** The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
18. **Exercise/Puppy Pens:** are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, **at all shows** licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.
19. **Dogs not entered for competition:** Dogs which are not being exhibited at all Breed Championship Shows must be entered as **NOT FOR COMPETITION**, for insurance purposes, prior to close of entries. Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of breed/s and name/s of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs and keep a record of same. Production of passes may be requested in any area of dispute. The fee for this facility shall be **Five Euro, (€5.00), per dog.**
20. **Puppies under the age of six (6) months should not** be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.

NOTE Addition to I.K.C. Rule 7 Section 1.

Every dog exhibited, or competing at any Show, Field Trial or Obedience Test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. In the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club, and dogs not of a recognised breed for which licences have been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working Test.

Failure to comply with the above will result in: (A) The dog being disqualified from the event and (B) the exhibitor being fined €127.00.

The implementation of this will be a normal (I.K.C.) Office routine.

Bangor welcomes our judging panel for 2022.

This year we have a full panel of Irish judges, from all breeds to progressing and also first time judges...

Angela McNally - well known for her successful 'Assisi' Dobermanns and Miniature Pinschers, she has also exhibited Pomeranians, we welcome Angela back to judge all Group 1 breeds, Group 1 some Group 2 breeds at Bangor. She will also judge Group 4.

Maureen Tate-Byrne – of Sidhhartha Tibetan Terriers, who will judge Group 2, Group 6 and Unlisted Group 5 breeds will also judge Group 2 for the first time. Another on a welcome return visit.

Ann Van Den Heuvel – Ann is a World renown Bulldog specialist whose opinion is sought across the continents; she has had great success over the years under her well known 'Beefeaterbulls' prefix, and we are delighted to have her judge her special breed at Bangor.

June Wall – known for her 'Everready' Rottweilers and Frenchies, and a Poodle specialist par excellence, both in exhibiting top Standards to high standards and now showing a Miniature, is judging a mix of breeds for us in Groups 2, 5 and 9. She is also judging Group 5, the Irish Native Breeds Group and Best Neuter in Show. June is also a Director of the IKC for several years. Welcome back to Bangor, June.

Barbara Evans – Good to have Barbara Evans judge her beloved Miniature Schnauzer breed at Bangor, her first Championship Show appointment under IKC Rules, although she was scheduled to judge the breed club show in May 2020, which was unfortunately cancelled due to Covid. A very active Schnauzer exhibitor under her Mount Slemish prefix in all three sizes, Bangor is pleased to help Barbara at last fulfil her ambition to judge her own breed and hope that her fellow breed exhibitors will support her.

John Bond – Well known for his top winning Kanesbrook Rottweilers, John judges across the palate of groups including 2, 3, 5, and 7, with many breeds in Group 8. He will give his opinion on the Terriers of Group 3 for Bangor, and also judge the actual Group. We welcome him on his first appointment at Bangor.

Clare O'Prey – Bangor is delighted to welcome Clare (McCusker) O'Prey to judge for the first time under IKC Rules. She will judge Bull Terriers, her own breed for many successful years under the Zracle prefix with her sister, and she has also enjoyed success in Bedlington Terriers and Australian Shepherds. We do hope that the Bull Terrier folk will support her.

Noreen Clarke – Welcome to Noreen Clarke, known for her Icemist Samoyeds, who has judged for us on several occasions, and this year she will judge all the Dachshund breeds, remarkably for the first time, though she is already qualified for Groups 1, 2, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10. Noreen will also judge Group 10.

Rita McCarry-Beattie – Rita is the first of our All Breeds judges to officiate at Bangor, adjudicating in Groups 5, 6 and 9, the latter Group being her own with the family 'Bichon Frise', and, until they moved to Group 3, Yorkshire Terriers, with which she had success to BIS level. Rita has judged all over Europe, Great Britain, Australia and Scandinavia.

Joanne Mullen – who shares her 'Broughadowey' Irish Wolfhound prefix with husband, William, who is also judging for us. She and Willie have had great success with their Wolfhounds over the past two decades, group and BIS wins included. Joanne is judging her final breeds through Groups 6 and 10, and judges Group 6 for the first time at Bangor.

William Mullen – William is progressing through Groups 6 & 10, and we hope this dedicated couple have a good entry with us on September 3rd.

Caroline Reynolds – Caroline already judges Group 4 and Group 8, groups in which she exhibits her Dachshunds and Clumber Spaniels respectively. Successful on both sides of the Irish sea, she often handles her sister, Wendy's, Pointer, with great success as well. She is judging Group 7 breeds and the Group and we wish her a pleasant day. Her sister.....

Wendy Fleming – who shares her Glenariff prefix with sister, Caroline, already judges Groups 4

and 7, and is following on with more Group 8 breeds with us at Bangor. Hopefully you will give her plenty of support.

Ger Philpott – of Weimaraner fame judges Groups 3, 4, 7 & 8 and also most of Group 10 but at Bangor it is his Group 8 experience we will put to use, with the Group decision as well. Ger also judges under KC London rules, awarding CCs in both Weimaraers and Cocker Spaniels. We welcome him to Bangor on his first visit.

Karen Murphy – known for her Rivendell Jaanese Chins, Karen is a Group 9 judge and at Bangor she will judge the Group and also some breeds in it. She is progressing through Group 10, and will judge a few Group 10 breeds for us. Not to be outdone, her Mother, **Shirley Murphy** – is progressing in Group 9, and we are pleased to help her to her group qualifications at Bangor.....

Colm Beattie – joins his wife Rita, at Bangor and is using his All Breeds qualifications to judge all our Stakes classes this year. Colm, like Rita, has judged in many countries and awards the Gundog Group under KC London rules as well as BIS all breeds FCI.

Hot food and coffee etc., will be provided ringside during the day.

The CLOUD NINE restaurant

at the venue is also open for exhibitors to relax and enjoy a home cooked meal.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Notice for schedule

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified) (**effective from the 1st January 2011**)

Breeds Not Separately Listed

Breeds entered in the Breeds Not Separately Listed at National Championship Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the Catalogue. A Judge may award a Green Star and Best of Breed in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded excellent or in the case of puppies "Very Promising" Effective from 1st January 2011.

Cropped Dogs

Cropped dogs are not permitted to be exhibited at any Irish Kennel Club licenced event.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.******

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

FIELD TRIAL CLASS is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stake.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

Neuter D/B – for any male or female who has been neutered following it's show career or for health reasons.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds unless entered in scheduled Baby Puppy Class. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; Great Japanese Dog and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (**Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed)**)

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas; three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

Videos

It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.

FOULING

Please keep in mind I.K.C. Rule, if your dog fouls the venue indoor or outdoor and you do not clean it up you will be fined £100. This year's committee will strictly enforce this rule.
