Show Rules, Regulations & Instructions to Exhibitors

- 1) **The Show** will be held under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- 2) **Venue-** The Show will be held at the **Mallow G.A.A. Sports Complex, Carrigoon, Mallow, Co. Cork on Sunday, 1st June 2025.**
3. **ENTRY FEES:** The entry fee will be based on the following scale:-

Breed Classes	€29.00 (£29 Stg) for 1st dog. Including I.K.C. Levy
Additional Dogs	€10.00 (£10 Stg) each. (Same ownership)
Baby Puppy	€10.00 (£10 Stg) each
Junior Handling	Free if entered in Breed otherwise €5.00 (£5 Stg) per dog per class
Puppy Stakes	€10.00 (£10 Stg) extra
Brace Stakes	€10.00 (£10 Stg) extra
Veteran Stakes	€10.00 (£10 Stg) extra
Champion Stakes	€10.00 (£10 Stg) extra

- 4) **Entries will be received up to the 14th May 2025**

- 4) **ENTRY FORMS : MISTAKES IN-** The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the Cork & District Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
- 5) **Rejection of Entries:** The committee reserve the right to reject any entry.
- 6) **Ineligible Entries:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in an age class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class if applicable in that breed otherwise to Open Class but in no other respects.
- 7) **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition at this show must be registered at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 36, Greenmount Office Park, Harolds Cross Bridge, Dublin 6.
- 8) **Rosettes** will be presented to all Best of Breed, Res. Best of Breed, Group, Puppy Stakes, Brace, Veteran and Best in Show winners. Also 1st to 4th place in Groups and Best in Show.
- 9) **A judge** shall be empowered to withhold any prize, prizes, or Green Stars if in his or her opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
- 10) **The show will be open to the public from 8.00 a. m. to 6.00 p.m.**
- 11) **Judging:** Judging will commence in all rings at 10.00 a.m. sharp, and no claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibi-

bition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by his handler.

- 12) **Catalogue** available at **€5.00 prepaid ONLY**
- 13) **Car Park: €5.00 prepaid /on Show Day**
- 14) **Persons** entering an exhibit or exhibits and failing to send them for exhibition or should their exhibit be rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon, will forfeit the entrance fees paid. While efforts will be made by the Stewards to see that every eligible dog present at the show will be brought into the Ring when required for judging, the Cork & District Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for the absence of any dog when the judging of a Breed or Class or Group is about to commence.
- 15) **Any Veterinary Surgeon** acting with the authority of the Show Committee may have any dog removed from the Show if: (i) suspected cause of infection or contagious disease; (ii) totally blind or deaf; (iii) vicious or savage disposition.
- 16) **In the event** of the appointed Judge failing to keep his engagement the Committee shall have the right to fill the vacancy thus caused.
- 17) **The Cork & District Canine Club** will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.
- 18) **During the exhibition of dogs**, the judge officiating will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
- 19) **Exercise/Puppy Pens:** are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, **at all shows** licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.
- 20) **Dogs not entered for competition:** Dogs which are not being exhibited at all Breed Championship Shows must be entered as NOT FOR COMPETITION, for insurance purposes, prior to close of entries. Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of breed/s and name/s of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs and keep a record of same. Production of passes may be requested in any area of dispute. The fee for this facility shall be Five Euro, (€5.00), per dog.
- 21) **Puppies under the age of six (6) months should not** be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.

Cropped Dogs

Cropped dogs are not permitted to be exhibited at any Irish Kennel Club licenced event.

Junior Handlers Note:

The minimum number of points required for a Junior Handler to qualify for the finals is now (17) points, compared to the previous ten (10) point qualification. It is also a requirement that only dogs owned by the member, or members immediate family, or in joint partnership shall be allowed to be handled in competition.

NOTE Addition To I.K.C. RULE 7 Section 1

Re: Registration of Dogs Entered

Addition to above Rule: Failure to comply with the above will result in:

- (A) **The Dog being disqualified from the event and**
- (B) **The exhibitor being fined €127.00**

The implementation of which shall be a Normal (I.K.C.) Office routine

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW, AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION ON THE ENTRY FORM.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

- 1.** The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
- 2.** Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
- 3.** No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
- 4.** A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
- 5.** Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
- 6.** Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
- 7.** In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
- 8.** Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
- 9.** If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Notice for schedule

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified)

Procedures will come into effect from the 1st January 2011

Breeds Not Separately Listed

Breeds entered in the Breeds Not Separately Listed at National Championship Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the Catalogue. A Judge may award a Green Star and Best of Breed in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded excellent or in the case of puppies "Very Promising" **Effective from 1st January 2011.**

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.******

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

FIELD TRIAL CLASS is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stake.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

Neuter Class;

The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.

Special Beginners Stakes; To be eligible to compete, neither the owner/handler or the dog will have won a Green Star prior to the entry closing date of the show.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; Great Japanese Dog and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 Great Japanese Dog and Class 3 Akita Inu/Great Japanese Dog (not yet assessed)

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

Videos

It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.
