Show Rules, Regulations and Instructions to Exhibitors

- 1. The Show will be held under licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force on the 1st. January 2024
- 2. **REGISTRATION etc.** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
- 3. Venue- The Show will be held at National Show Centre, Cloghran Swords, Co. Dublin on Saturday 30th November, 2024 between the hours of 7.30 am and 6 pm.

5. Judging: Will commence at 9.00 am. sharp, including Junior Handling.

The majority of rings will be indoors some rings may be outdoors

No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late.

No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.

Exhibitors will not be allowed to wear a badge or other decoration, in the Breed Judging Ring save for the exhibition number of each dog which must be clearly displayed by the exhibitor. The following officials of the Show will not be permitted to exhibit there at. Viz: a Judge, a Veterinary Surgeon, a Steward (except when acting as such and in the execution of his duties), the Secretary or any member of the Committee.

6. Fees of exhibits arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited.

No entries will be accepted without the appropriate entry fees, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

- 8. Closing of the Show: All exhibits must be removed by the person in charge, or by their owners not later than half an hour after completion of the Judging of Best in Show.
- **9. Judge's Decision:** The decision of a Judge at the termination of his or her judging a Class shall be final, except in the case of an objection properly made and upheld under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club or where a Judge states that a clerical or other mistake was made in the award as Officially returned, or on the grounds of fraud.
- 10. Protests: All protests must be made in the manner specified in the Irish Kennel Club Rules.
- 11. Judges: If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her engagement, the Committee reserves the right to employ another judge. The right is reserved to the Show Committee to change a judge in a breed or breeds or part of a breed if it is considered such change is in the best interest of the Show.
- 12. ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS: appearing in the Our Dogs Ireland Facebook pages in reference to any alterations made by the Committee, or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice there of.
- 13. **RESPONSIBILITY:** Exhibitors will please understand that while every reasonable precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of the exhibits and exhibitors; **The Committee** shall not be responsible for loss or damage sustained through accident or otherwise
- **14.** Visitors are requested not to handle the dogs sent for exhibition.
- 15. IN CONNECTION WITH THE SHOW:

The Committee shall be he Show Committee within the meaning of the Rules, and all disputes arising shall be dealt with by this committee in accordance with the powers delegated to it by the Council. Should any dispute arise for which a specific rule is not provided such matter in dispute shall be referred to the General Purpose Committee for decision. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Council of the Irish Kennel Club.

- 18. Dogs on Show Grounds: Only dogs entered are allowed on the Show Grounds. Dogs entered Not for Competition are not allowed in the Ring Areas
- 19. Fouling: A minimum fine of €20.00 shall be imposed on any exhibitor who fails to clean up after the fouling by their dogs in the precincts of the show.
- 20. All Dogs competing must be on a lead, unless in Obedience or Agility
- 21. INELIGIBLE ENTRIES: A transfer of an incorrect entry <u>as to sex or breed</u> may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog <u>entered in an age class</u> for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the <u>next appropriate age class</u> <u>if applicable</u> in that breed, but in no other respects.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW, AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION ON THE ENTRY FORM.

Failure to comply with the above will result in: The Dog being disqualified from the event <u>and</u>

The exhibitor being fined €130.00

The implementation of which shall be a Normal (I.K.C.) Office Routine.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

- 1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
- 2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
- No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
- 4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
- Groups will be divided into ten sections as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
- 6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
- In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
- 8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
- 9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Notice for schedule

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified) (effective from the 1st January 2011)

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award other than Best Baby Puppy in Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champion Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

Neuter class Neutered Male and Neutered Female are confined to this class can compete for Best Neuter In Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show. (They may not compete for the Green Star)

FIELD TRIAL CLASS is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stake.

.**Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

Special Beginners Stakes:

A new stakes class to help promote newcomers to the scene and also to encourage some competing in the more numerically strong breeds. To be eligible to compete, neither the owner/handler or the dog will have won a Green Star prior to the entry closing date of the show. This class can be offered at any show. This is judged on the quality of the dog and placings are 1-4 as in the other stakes classes. The organising Show Society decide the prizes they wish to offer (and if they want to charge an entry fee. In the event that a dog is co owned, all owners must fulfil the criteria).

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in **ONE BREED CLASS ONLY** (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds unless entered in Baby Puppy Class. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibit.

NO CHANGE OF CLASS ALLOWED, OTHER THAN FOR GENUINE PRINTERS ERROR

OBEDIENCE CLASS DEFINITIONS

Under General Rules

Food or any other article may not be given or carried in the ring, with the exception of Pre-Beginners and Beginners where a non-squeaky/non-audible toy may be carried by the handler.

PRE -BEGINNERS OBEDIENCE CLASS

Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded **three** first prizes (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Limited Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club Limited.

Handlers may carry a non-squeaky/audible toy in their hand or pocket and reward the dog by playing with that toy for up to 20 seconds at the end of each exercise with the exception of the stay test. The dog is not allowed to play with the toy during the exercise.

BEGINNERS OBEDIENCE CLASS

Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or awarded **four** or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks)) in any obedience test, other than Pre-Beginners Obedience Class, under Irish Kennel Club Limited Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club Limited.

Handlers may carry a non-squeaky/non-audible toy in their hand or pocket and reward the dog by playing with that toy for up to 20 seconds at the end of each exercise with the exception of the stay test. The dog is not allowed to play with the toy during the exercise.

NOVICE OBEDIENCE CLASS

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience class other than in Beginners Obedience class.

CLASS A OBEDIENCE

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience Class other than in Beginners and Novice Obedience classes

CLASS B OBEDIENCE

Old Rule:- Down five (5) minutes (30 points). Handler out of sight. New Rule:- Down four (4) minutes (30 points). Handler out of sight.

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded a Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience Classes with the exception of Beginners, Novice or Class A Obedience.
