It is with great honour we welcome FCI, International All Breeds Judge Mr Shharat Sharma from India to judge our breed club show. Mr Sharma has judged around the world at multiple prestigious international dog shows in South Africa, Philippines, Thailand, Australia, New Zealand, Indonesia, China, Malaysia, Romania, Germany, USA, Brazil, Argentina and several specialty shows in Inda.

Mr Sharma began showing in 1979 with his first KCI registered Labrador bitch and over the years maintained his passion for gun dogs by adding Golden Retrievers, Irish Setters, German Short Haired Pointers and Cocker Spaniels to his kennels during the decade to follow. Mr Sharma achieved great success with over 20 champions made in each of these breeds. Special mention to his Irish Setter Ch. Eireannmada Manhattan who was declared reserve dog of the year in 1998-99. In the early 1990s, Mr Sharma devoted his kennels to Beagles and Boxers. Mr Sharma is an advocate for strengthening the Boxer type and temperament and utilised imported lines from Australia, the US and old English lines available in Inda as well as importing dogs to establish his lines.

When Mr Sharma is not in the show ring, judging or exhibiting, he is an advocate for responsible pet ownership and is the founder and Secretary of GUR-GAON KENNEL CLUB, India.

On behalf of the Dalmatian Club of Ireland, we wish a very warm Irish welcome to Mr. Sharma and extend our gratitude to the Hound Association of Ireland for their support of such a prestigious judge.

SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1. Jurisdiction The show will be held under the licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club as in force on the day of publication of this schedule..
- 2. Registration, etc. All dogs entered for competition, or otherwise, must be registered at the Irish Kennel club, Fottrell House, Unit 36, Greenmount office Park, Dublin 6W.
- 3. **Ring Numbers** Will be given out on the day of the show.
- 4. **Rosettes** will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Reserve in each Class. Cups and trophies will be presented to paid-up members of the All Ireland Dalmatian Club only and are offered under Club conditions.
- 5. **Exhibits** Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times.
- 6. **Judge** In the event of the appointed judge failing to keep his/her engagement, the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
- 7. **Interpretation** All disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the committee. Parties to such a dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club.
- 8. Accident or Damage The club shall not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
- 9. Veterinary Examination The Veterinary Surgeon in attendance will have the power to exclude any exhibit which, in his opinion, is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of disease, vice, lice or other causes.
- 10. **Entries** The Committee reserve the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES AT BREED CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

(All age classes computed from date of birth.)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. (.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.*

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Neutered Class: The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in <u>ONE BREED CLASS ONLY</u> (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

Dogs entered in restricted classes must also be entered in one of the Standard Classes for the breed. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor.
