SHOW REGULATIONS

- Jurisdiction:** The show will be held under the rules and regulations of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force on the 1st January 2022 and a copy of the Licence will be posted in the secretary's office on the day of the show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
 - Regulations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be Registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without any further registrations.
 - Venue:** The Show will be held at **Ferry House, Waterford Road. Clonmel, Co. Tipperary**
 - Admission:**

Caravans overnight stay €15.00
Catalogue €4.00 prepaid or alternatively €5.00 on day of Show
ALL PREPAID CATALOGUES MUST BE COLLECTED BY 11 am.

- The promoting body reserve the right to refuse entry.
 - Rejecting Entries:** The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, advert or other insertion into the catalogue.
 - Ineligible Entries:** If before judging of a class or classes in which a dog entered, an exhibitor reports he/she has entered the dog in a class for which it is not eligible he/she may be permitted to transfer his/her entry to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed or sex. No other transfers of an ineligible entry are permitted.
 - Entry Forms (mistakes in):** The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by exhibitors and while every endeavour will be made to have the forms correctly interoperated the promoting body cannot accept responsibility for mistakes therein.

11. As there are no entry fees being charged, there will be no prize money. Special prizes offered for competition by or through a specialist club shall be collected and distributed by the club.
12. **Veterinary Examination:** The Veterinary Surgeon on call will have the power to exclude any exhibit, which in his opinion, is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of Disease, lice or other cause.
13. **Judges:** In the event of any appointed Judge failing to keep his/her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge/Judges
14. **Judging:** (a) will commence 9:30 am sharp, except Junior Handling which will commence at 09:00 am Sharp. (b) No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. (c) The Exhibition number of each dog must be displayed clearly by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring. (d) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the Ring.
15. **All announcements** appearing in the "Evening Herald" prior to the closing of entries or in reference to any alterations made by the Club in the schedule or in these regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
16. **Interpretation:** The Committee of the Déise Canine Club within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Club Rules, all disputes if any, shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club.
17. **Responsibility:** The Déise Canine Club will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.
18. All Exhibits must be kept on leads.

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED

Note Addition to I.K.C. Rule 131

Every dog exhibited, or competing at any show, Field Trial or Obedience Test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. in the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club and dogs not of a recognised breed for which licences have been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working tests.

Failure to comply with the above will result in:

(a) The Dog being disqualified from the event and

(b) The exhibitor being fined €130.00

The implementation of which shall be a normal (I.K.C.) office routine.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW, AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION ON THE ENTRY FORM.

OVERNIGHT CAMPING.

- €15 overnight prepaid,.
- Only those prepaid will be permitted on site before 4:30pm.
- Camping area opens at 3pm on the 30th June and will remain so to show entrants until 10pm that evening.
- Camping is strictly within the indicated cordoned off area as indicated by the personnel manning the gate.
- Any camper / caravan deemed to be parked in a manner that would impact on the health and safety of others will be requested to vacate the site and will be removed if refusing to comply with any reasonable request to remedy said health and safety issue.
- Late arrivals will not be entertained and no refunds will be forthcoming due to late arrival.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Notice for schedule

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified)

Procedures will come into effect from the 1st January 2011

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'dog' denotes both sexes)

In the following definitions, the award which counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any Governing body recognised by the Irish Kennel Club will be regarded as the equivalent of a Green Star. Similarly the title of Champion is continued as if it were attained under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club.

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award other than Best Baby Puppy in Show.

Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 6 and under 12 months of age on the day of the Show

Junior Class is confined to dogs over 9 and under 18 months of age on the day of the Show.

Intermediate Class is confined to dogs over 15 and under 24 months on the day of the Show.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Champion Class is confined to dogs that have attained the title of Champion under the Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or other Kennel Authority recognised by the Irish Kennel Club.

Veteran Class is confined to dog over 8 years of age on the day of the Show .Please note a **Veteran dog who has attained the title of Champion, may enter the Veteran or Champion Class but not both,**

Field Trial Class is confined to dogs who have won at least a reserve in a Puppy, Novice, Derby or Open Stake as defined in the Field Trial Rules & Regulations. (Compulsory at All Breed Championship Shows for Groups 7 & 8)

A copy of the relevant win at Field Trial must accompany the entry form.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

Brace Class is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

Stakes Classes are limited to Puppy, Veteran, Brace Junior Special Beginners and Team and are open to more than one breed or variety. All exhibits in stakes classes except for those entered in Veteran Stakes, must be entered in a standard breed class.

Dogs entered in restricted classes must also be entered in one of the Standard Classes for the breed. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

There is limited space for grooming tents on the showground's. Also for health and safety purposes no flammable equipment (for example portable cookers or portable barbeques) are allowed on the show grounds. Especially in the grooming tent area. The officers and committee members would greatly appreciate all exhibitors co-operation in this matter.

Videos

It is an Irish Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission should also be obtained from the ring judge on the day.

AKITA EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds American Akita and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita Dog (not yet assessed))

It is envisaged that the number of unassessed dogs will decrease over the next six months and eventually all Akitas will be designated as America Akita or Akita Inu.
