#### **Show Rules, Regulations & Instructions to Exhibitors**

- 1. The Show will be held under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- Venue- The Show will be held at The Ferryhouse Sports Complex, Waterford Road, Clonmel, on Saturday, 4<sup>th</sup> May 2024.

#### ALL Rings will be outdoors regardless of the weather

3. ENTRY FEES: The entry fee will be based on the following scale:-

(Figures in brackets denote Sterling) Dogs registered in partnerships or joint owners are treated as separate entries even when forwarded by single owners.

- 5. ENTRY FORMS: MISTAKES IN- The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the Fermoy Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
- **6. Rejecting Entries etc.**: The committee reserve the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue or allocation of stand space at the show
- 7. Ineligible Entries: A transfer of an incorrect entry as to the sex or breed is allowed if reported to the secretary's office prior to the commencing of judging; a dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the open class in that breed, but in no other respects.
- **8. Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition at this show must be registered at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 36, Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6.
- Rosettes will be presented to all Green Stars, Best of Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Breed, Best Veteran in Breed, Group 1-4 (including all Puppy Groups)
   Stakes Classes and Best in Show
- 10. A judge shall be empowered to withhold any prize, prizes, or Green Stars if in his or her

- opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
- 11. The show will be open to the public from 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.
- 12. Judging: Judging will commence in all rings at 9.30 a.m. sharp, except. Junior handling which will start at 9.00am sharp, and no claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by his handler.
- 13. The committee do not accept any responsibility for any loss or damage to vehicles whilst in the car park/caravan park.
- **14. ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS** appearing in any daily newspaper or other publication in reference to any alterations made by the Show Committee in the Schedule or in these regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
- 15. Persons entering an exhibit or exhibits and failing to send them for exhibition or should their exhibit be rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon, will forfeit the entrance fees paid. While efforts will be made by the Stewards to see that every eligible dog present at the show will be brought into the Ring when required for judging, the Fermoy Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for the absence of any dog when the judging of a Breed or Class or Group is about to commence.
- **16.** Any Veterinary Surgeon acting with the authority of the Show Committee may have any dog removed from the Show if: (i) suspected cause of infection or contagious disease; (ii) totally blind or deaf; (iii) vicious or savage disposition.
- 17. In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his engagement the Committee shall have the right to fill the vacancy thus caused.
- **18.** The Fermoy Canine Club will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.
- **19.** During the exhibition of dogs, the judge officiating will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
- 20. EXHIBITS: Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibit under proper control at all times. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES ANYWHERE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS
- 21. Exercise/Puppy Pens: are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, at all shows licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.
- **22. Dogs not entered for competition:** Dogs which are not being exhibited at all Breed Championship Shows must be entered as NOT FOR COMPETITION, for insurance purposes, prior to close of entries. Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of breed/s and name/s of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs and keep a record of same. Production of passes may be requested in any area of dispute. The fee for this facility shall be Five Euro, (€5.00), per dog.

#### RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

- 1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
- 2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
- No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
- **4.** A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
- Groups will be divided into ten sections as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
- **6.** Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
- In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3<sup>rd</sup> etc. to 4<sup>th</sup> place, absentees MUST be marked.
- **8.** Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
- 9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

#### **Introducing our Judges**

#### We extend a 'Céad Míle Fáilte' to all our judges.

- **Ms. A. Boonemmer (Netherlands):** Breeding GSD's since 1987 under the prefix "Vom Haus Lacherom", Anja is chairman of the GSD breeding *club DHRN* in the Netherlands. Judging since 1997, Anja has judged throughout Europe, Indonesia, New Zealand and Mexico.
- **Mrs. M. Butcher (Australia):** On her first appointment in Ireland, Matina, a Terrier Specialist judge, is also licenced to judge all Terriers, Utility, Hound and Non-Sporting breeds. Matina has successfully bred, shown and imported Fox Terriers and St. Bernards.
- Mrs. E. Gunter (Australia): Well known for their top winning 'Guntop' Boxers, Elizabeth with her late husband founded the Guntop Kennels over forty years ago. Daschunds are now also part of this famous Australian kennel. Elizabeth is an all breeds judge who has judged in all continents. This is Elizabeth's first appointment in Ireland.
- **Mr. Z. Jojkic (Serbia):** President of Dachshund Club in Serbia, Zlatko is owner of the Avaline Kennel which has produced numerous national champions, International champions, World show winners and European show winners. An FCI all-breed judge since 2022, Zlatko is on a return visit to Ireland
- **Mr. M. Nilsson (Sweden):** FCI judge for groups, 3, 4, 5, 9 & 10, Mikael is on a return visit to Ireland. A Poodle specialist who exhibits under the Kudos prefix since 1993, Mikael has enjoyed great success in all poodle sizes. He has judged throughout the world including the Poodle Club of America National Speciality.
- Ms. M. Sargent (UK): Well-recognized Working, Pastoral & Utility group judge, Marion is qualified to award CCs in approx. 60 breeds across all Groups. Marion's first breed was the American Akita being the first person to bring the breed into England in the 1980s. She also owned the first AA Champion which was also the first All Breed Championship Show BIS winner. Marion's interest has extended to Briard's and subsequently French Bulldogs.
- Mr. D. Scalfari (Italy): Over the years Donato has been a breeder and exhibitor of Epagneul Breton, Pointers, Kurzhaars, English Setters and in recent years Braco Italiano. A Gundog specialist judge who has been judging since 2010, Donato judged Bracos at the WDS in 2023. This is Donato's first visit to Ireland.
- Ms. C. van den Bergh (South Africa): A hound specialist judge, Clair has been involved with dogs all of her life firstly with her parents Irish Wolfhounds ("Morgalen") and subsequently with her own Afghan Hound kennel "Scaramouche". Judging since 1999, Clair has enjoyed judging throughout the world. This is Clair's first appointment in Ireland

#### **Irish Judges at Fermoy 2024:**

Our **Best in Show Judge** this year is **Mr. Stephen Hourihan**, "Fastnetrock". Stephen's name is synonymous with **Fermoy**, having worked tirelessly and supported the Club for over 40 years. We are extremely honored to have Stephen judge our 15<sup>th</sup> All Breeds International Show.

Fermoy are delighted to also welcome our other Irish Judges to our panel of 2024, Mr. William Dobbin, Mrs. Marion Finney, Mr. Trevor McVea & Dr. John Yek, all of whose reputation as breeders and exhibitors in their respective breeds and as judges both at home and abroad make them very well known to all exhibitors.

#### **Cropped Dogs**

Cropped dogs are not permitted to be exhibited at any Irish Kennel Club licenced event.

#### NOTE: I.K.C. RULE 7 Section 1 Re: Registration of Dogs Entered

Failure to comply with the above will result in:

- (A) The Dog being disqualified from the event and
- (B) The exhibitor being fined €127.00

The implementation of which shall be a Normal (I.K.C.) Office routine

#### **CLASS DEFINITIONS**

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

**Baby Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over four and under six months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition other than Best Baby Puppy in Show

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under nine months of age on the day of the Show. (Puppies may not compete for the Green Star or CACIB)

A Junior Class is for dogs between nine and eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. (Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to compete for the CACIB but may compete for the Green Star)

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show.

**Champions Class** is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club rules or under another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries. \*\*

Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show (Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to compete for the CACIB)

\*\* Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both. \*\*

Working Class To enter a dog in working class, the entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the FCI compulsory certificate containing the confirmation-by the member country in which the holder and/or owner has his permanent place of residence that the dog has passed the test as well as details about this test. The only breeds eligible for the working class are those appearing as working breeds in the FCI Breed Nomenclature, taking into account the exceptions granted to some countries for some breeds.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in <u>ONE BREED CLASS ONLY</u> (No double entries)

The decisive date in respect of age is the day the dog is shown.

#### **Neuter Class**;

The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.

#### Irish Kennel Club C.A.C.I.B. and Green Star Show

The F.C.I. require that Judges must compare each individual exhibit to their standard and grade them accordingly. Dogs of exceptional quality are considered for C.A.C.I.B. (Int. Certificate) and Green Star (National Certificate).

#### 1. Grading:

After each examination all dogs must be graded one of the following by the judge i.e. "E" (Excellent), "V.G." (Very Good). "G" (Good), "S" (Sufficient) Cannot be judged or Disqualified and Puppy Grading: Promising, Very Promising, Sufficient and Cannot be judged. Each exhibitor will be given a Grading Card by the Steward.

#### 2. Green Star (National Title)

Only unbeaten dogs <u>Graded Excellent</u> are eligible to challenge for the Green Star. <u>Reserve Green Star</u>: Confined to dogs beaten only by the Green Star Winner and <u>Graded</u> <u>Excellent.</u>

#### 3. C.A.C.I.B. and Reserve:

Confined to the winners of the Intermediate, Open and Champion's class graded **Excellent.** 

#### Note:

- a. Where a dog under 15 months wins a Green Star and is not eligible for the C.A.C.I.B. the Judge Must award it to another qualified dog.
- **a.** All grades and awards must be completed by the Judge in the Judges book

#### 5. Best Puppy in Breed

Confined to puppies entered in puppy class who have been awarded the **Grade of Very Promising** 

 Best Veteran in Breed: Confined to dogs entered in the veteran class who have been awarded the <u>Grade of Excellent</u>

#### **BEST BABY PUPPY IN SHOW**

In addition to the standard Groups, there will be **A Baby Puppy Group** in which all Best Baby Puppy in Breed will challenge for Best Baby Puppy In Show. The Best Baby Puppy in each breed will be eligible to compete in this Group.

#### **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW**

In addition to the standard Groups, Puppy Groups will be scheduled and the winner of each Puppy Group may proceed to challenge for Best Puppy in Show.

The Best Puppy in each breed will be eligible to compete in their respective Group.

#### **BEST VETERAN IN SHOW**

In addition to the standard Groups, there will be A Veteran Group in which all Best Veterans in Breed will challenge for Best Veteran in Show.

The Best Veteran in each breed (unless it wins Best of it's own Breed) will be eligible to compete in this Group.

If a Veteran wins Best of it's own Breed it will not be eligible to compete in the Veteran Group, but will proceed like All Best of Breed winners to compete in the standard group classification to challenge for Best in Show.

#### **Competition for Green Star and/or CACIB**

- The Junior Class winners that have been graded Excellent Grades will compete for the Green Star but NOT for the CACIB.
- The Intermediate Class winner if Graded Excellent will compete for the Green Star and the CACIB.
- The winners of the **Open** Class and **Champions** Class, if **Graded Excellent** will compete for the **Green Star** and the **CACIB**.
- The winner of the Veteran Class, if Graded Excellent will compete for the Green Star but NOT for the CACIB
- The Puppy Class winners that are Graded Very Promising will compete for Best Puppy in Breed, will be chosen after the Best of Breed, and will go onto compete in the Main Ring for "Best Puppy In Group" Only.
- The Veteran Class winners that are Graded Excellent will compete for Best Veteran in Breed, will be chosen after the Best of Breed competition. Winners will compete in the Main Ring for "Best Veteran in Show".

#### INTERNATIONAL BEAUTY CHAMPION

The Irish Kennel Club can only apply to the F. C. I. for this title in respect of Dogs Owned by Irish Residents. All others must apply directly to their own National Kennel Club.

#### **Breeds not separately listed at International Championship Shows**

All Breeds qualified by the FCI to compete for the International Beauty Title must be afforded the opportunity to do so at All Breed International Shows. In order to facilitate this, the Any Variety Class is replaced by a class entitled **Breeds Not Listed** which must be scheduled in each of the ten groups.

Entries received in this class must be divided into breed sections. A Judge may award a CACIB, Green Star, and Best of Breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality.

When entries are received Judges for these classes will be allocated by the show promoting body and exhibitors informed when they are sent their ring numbers. The names of the judges will be listed in the catalogue.

#### **DISABLED PARKING**

A limited number of spaces will be available on a first come basis.

Any vehicles parked illegally on these spaces will be removed

## **Extract from F.C.I. Regulations for Judges at CACIB Shows**

The dogs that the judge handles at a CACIB-show, where he/she is not acting as a judge must be either bred, owned or co-owned by him, a partner, a member of his immediate family or any person living with him/her in his/her household.

Dogs that have attained the title of CHAMPION with another FCI Kennel Club, resident in another FCI country, who win a Green Star at an Irish Kennel Club <u>International Show</u> will be awarded an Irish Kennel Club Championship title.

#### The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; Akita Inu and American Akita - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed)

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.


