Great Danes have been my passion since 1992 when I purchased my first Great Dane, a black bitch named Abby (Ch Donnadane's Abby Dark Grumbles). Abby led me to my mentors and long time friends Phil and Jane Gray of Owlwatch kennels. Thru Phil and Jane I purchased a dog named Cooper (BISS Ch Owlwatch Heir Ways) who became my first



owner handled champion. Cooper sired 9 Champions including Best of Breed at Westminster (BISS Ch Creekside-Bayside Just Tina, HOF, ROM), #1 Great Dane in India (Ch Creekside Stryker of Vidane), and my first owner handled black dog Gus, (Ch Remo's Tropical Storm Gustov).

I've bred or owned 10 Champions; black, fawn and brindle. I've owner handled seven dogs to AKC Champion titles including three BISS winners, two Multiple Group placers and Top 20 placer, Benny (BISS GDCS Remo's Inspector Clouseau) who was ranked GDCA #12 in 2017. Some of my most memorable moments were at the 2014 GDCA National Specialty when Benny was awarded RWD and Best Puppy and then competing with him in the Top 20 Invitational in 2018.

I've been a member of the Great Dane Club of America since 2005 and am currently serving as 2nd VP. I also service as a Trustee on the GDCA Charitable Trust. I am a past member and President of the Hoosier Great Dane Club (Indiana) and a past member of the GDC of Oxford (Connecticut). I currently live in Savannah, GA, USA.

Good luck to all the breeders, owners and exhibitors and thank you for inviting me to judge the Irish Great Dane Club Breed Championship Show. It is an honor to be invited to judge your show.

IGDC /EuDDC Standardised Assessment for Breeding Saturday 6th 2024

In conjunction with our Breed Championship Shows

We will continue to give you the opportunity to all responsible breeders to have your Great Danes assessed for breeding using the EuDDC approved assessment format. Only Danes which have passed their assessment will be eligible to go on the EuDDC breeding (stud) register.

Dogs and Bitches who succeed in the assessment and have also undergone the requisite health tests will be eligible to go on both the IGDC and DDC breeding/conformation registers.

You must book your place in the assessment using the show entry form, dogs in the assessment do not necessarily have to be entered in the championship show. Fee for assessment is €45 per dog.

Dogs must be at least 15 months old on the day of the assessment and should preferably have had their health checks done. At present the health check for Hip Dysplasia & Elbows are compulsory, Dogs should have valid DCM certificate at time of mating.

Please bring copies of your dogs Registration Certificate and All Health Check Certificates to the assessment.

Dogs may be provisionally assessed subject to Health Checks being completed in the near future. Dogs cannot pass the assessment until copies of their Health Certificates have been provided.

Please note before being assessed by the judges, each dog will undergo an initial health check by our vet. This will include a scan for the microchip identification. **Dog(s) must be identifiable by Microchip**.

Breeding assessments are available only if booked in advance. Please contact the Show Secretary Joanne Doyle if you are interested in having one or more of your dogs assessed.

These will take place in a ring parallel to the club show.

Assessments will be scheduled to avoid clashes with Show Competition.

All dogs over 6 months must be entered one and only one of the STANDARD CLASSES 1– 12 one (only one)

Class Definitions

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word "dog" denotes both sexes)

A BABY PUPPY CLASS is confined to dogs of four months and under six months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. Baby puppies cannot compete in any other class

A PUPPY CLASS is confined to dogs of six months and under twelve months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth

A JUNIOR CLASS is for dogs between nine months and eighteen calendar months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth

AN INTERMEDIATE CLASS is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

AN OPEN CLASS is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A CHAMPIONS CLASS is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

A VETERAN CLASS is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

A SPECIAL BEGINNERS CLASS. Neither owner, exhibit, nor handler to have won a first prize in the Breed at any Show

A PROGENY CLASS to be judged on the merits of progeny a sire or dam with minimum three and maximum five of his progeny (first generation, sons/daughters). Progeny must be present at, and entered in, at least one class at this Show.

A BREEDERS CLASS consisting of minimum three and maximum five exhibits of the same breed and variety, without distinction of sex, bred by the same person (same kennel name), even if they are not his property. each exhibit having been entered in one of the standards classes on the day.

A BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team

A TEAM CLASS is for three, or more, exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person,

SPECIAL CLASSES: Dogs entered in Special or Restricted Classes must also be entered in one of the standard classes for the Breed

NOTE: Dogs under the age of 4 months are not eligible to compete at this Show. All dogs must be registered or transferred at The Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor

The Irish Kennel Club will impose a fine of €100 for those failing to comply with this regulation.

Show Regulations

- 1. **JURISDICTION**: The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of The Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force at closing date of entries.
- 2. **JUDGING:** Judging will commence at **12:00 noon**
- 3. **JUDGE:** In the event of our appointed Judge failing to keep his/her engagement, the committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge.
- REGISTRATION: All dogs, entered, for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at The Irish Kennel Club Ltd., Greenmount Park, Dublin 6W.
- 5. **INTERPRETATION:** The Committee of The Irish Great Dane Club shall be the "Show Committee" within the meaning of The Irish Kennel Club Ltd. Rules and all disputes, (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to The Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- During the exhibition of dogs, the Judge Officiating will **not** allow, under any circumstances, any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
- 7. Entries Close 17th June 2024 (postmark), Entries can be made on-line at www.DogShowEntry.ie until midnight of June 25th, 2024

- 9. **Fouling**: Exhibitors are subject to a fine of €25.00 if they fail to clean up fouling by their dogs within the precinct of the Show. **This rule will be strictly enforced.**
- 10. **Trophies** are only awarded to fully paid up members of the club.
- **11. Overseas members** Only members of five or more years are entitled to bring trophies out of the country
