SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1) **JURISDICTION.** The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force on the date of closing of Entries. The abridged Rules and Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club will be displayed at the Show. A "Dog" in the following Rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
- 2) **VENUE.** The Show will be held at St. Michaels, GAA Club, Carlanstown, Co. Meath., on Saturday 18th September 2021 between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.
- 3) **ENTRY FEES: €20.00 for the first dog including online catalogue, €10.00 for second, and €10.00 for third dog. Four dogs or more €50.00. Baby Puppy €3.00**

- b) **ENTRY FORMS . MISTAKES IN :** The Catalogue will be completed from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the Irish Dachshund Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of The Irish Kennel Club Rule 15 Section 1 or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
- 4) a) **REJECTION OF ENTRIES:** The Promoting Body shall have the right to reject any entry, advertisement or any other insertion in the catalogue or the allocation of stand space at the Show.
b) **INELIGIBLE ENTRIES** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class in that breed but in no other respects.
- 5) **REGISTRATIONS :** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., Fottrell House, Harold's Cross Bridge, Dublin 6W.
- 6) **PRIZES :** Rosettes will be given for Best-in-Show, Reserve Best-in-Show, Best of Breed and Green Star winners, Reserve Green Star winners and for First to Reserve in all classes also Best Puppy in Show, Best Baby Puppy in Show and Best Veteran in Show..
- 7) **JUDGING** will commence at 11.00am sharp . The Show will open at 10.00am. In the event of the judge failing to keep his/her appointment the Committee shall have the right to appoint another judge.
- 8) **RESPONSIBILITY:**
The Promoting Body will not be responsible for loss or damage sustained by an Exhibitor, Exhibit or any person at the show through accident or otherwise, or for any loss, direct or indirect occasioned by any mistake or omission in the catalogue. .

CLASS DEFINITIONS

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show. **Baby Puppies** are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award other than Best Baby Puppy in Show

Puppy

Class is confined to dogs over 6 and under 12 months of age on the day of the Show

Junior

Class is confined to dogs over 9 and under 18 months of age on the day of the Show.

Intermediate

Class is confined to dogs over 15 and under 24 months on the day of the Show.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Open

Class is confined to dog over 15 months on the day of the Show.

Champion

Class is confined to dogs that have attained the title of Champion under the Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or other Kennel Authority recognised by the Irish Kennel Club.

Veteran

Class is confined to dog over 8 years of age on the day of the Show * A Veteran dog who has attained the title of Champion, may enter the Veteran or Champion Class but not both,

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

Restricted / Special Classes (i.e. Colour Classes etc) The dog must be entered in one of the standard classes scheduled for the breed, as above.

NB Best of Breed is confined to Green Star Winners

NB All class winners graded Excellent or Very Promising may challenge for the Green Star

COVID PROTOCOLS ON SHOWDAY

- Exhibitors will not be allowed to setup at the ring side.
- Each ring will have a designated collection area with clearly marked entrance and exit.
- 2m spaces in the collection ring and exhibiting ring
- Each ring will have a designated grooming area.
- With clearly marked entrance and exit.
- Designated Grooming areas will be located sufficiently away from the show rings.
- Grooming and holding areas will be available to breeds 30 minutes prior to judging of their breed.
- Exhibitors must vacate the area on completion of judging of their breed
- Group Competition:
 - it is expected that only Best of Breed winners remain at the venue after breed competition is complete.
- An area for tents/gazebos will be allocated
- There will be no seating available at the show and no crates set up around the ring.
- Exhibitors may bring their own tents/gazebos and seating for use only which must be placed inside their tent/gazebo.
- Tents/Gazebo must only be for their use by their family/travelling pod. • All tents/gazebos must be 2 metres apart.
- All exhibitors are reminded not to have parties in each other's tents/gazebos and to comply with the social distancing requirements.
- All exhibitors must wear masks or shields, this will be compulsory for all gatherings going forward.
- Where possible exhibitors should only handle dogs from their own Household, in the event that an additional handler is required, we recommend the exhibitor uses someone from their own travel pod.
- No hairdryers or blasters allowed.
- ****All PPE equipment and rubbish must be disposed of correctly to avoid the spread of the virus ****
- No overnight camping will be allowed on the venue
- Due to space, we request no campers be brought into the carpark.
- Exhibitors are reminded to maintain social distance at all times in the car park.
- Please park where directed by car park attendants.
- Exhibitors must use designated access and egress routes to the show grounds
