Show regulations

JURISDICTION

The show will be held under licence of the Irish Kennel Club as in force at the date of publication of the schedule.

REGISTRATION;

All dogs entered for Competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club, Fottrell House, Harolds Cross Bridge, Dublin 6W. Tel +353 (1) 4533300

VENUE:

The show will be held at Navan Racecourse, Proudstown Rd, Navan, Co Meath C15A623 on the 02 October 2021

ENTRIES:

Entries will be online on www.dogshowentry.ie enquires to show secretary Mr David Galvin, Telephone 00353870518025.

The promoting body reserves the right to refuse any entry. The secretary will not be responsible for entries not received. No entry will be accepted on the day.

A transfer of an incorrect entry as to the sex may be allowed by the secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in an age class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class if applicable but in no other respects.

FEES:

1st dog Euro 21/ Stg £21, additional dogs Euro 8 /Stg £8. Baby puppy class Euro 8 / stg £8.

Fees for exhibits arriving late or failing to arrive or rejected on veterinary grounds will be forfeited. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate fees, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

CATALOGUE: Printed Catalogue Prepaid for Members included in Entry Fee - €2 for non members.

Otherwise catalogues must be prepaid with entry; there will be no catalogues for sale on show day

VETERINARY EXAMINATION: The veterinary surgeons in attendance will have the power to exclude any exhibit, which in their opinion is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of disease etc.

JUDGE:

In the event of the appointed judge failing to keep his or her engagement, the committee shall have the right to appoint another judge.

JUDGING:

(a) Breed Judging will commence at 11.00 am. No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late.

(b) No person will be allowed in the judging ring except the judge, show officials or

an exhibitor talking in a dog for adjudication.

(c) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler who shall not wear a badge or any other decoration in the judging ring.

(d) The club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident or damage by exhibitors, exhibits or other persons attending the show.

INTERPRETATION:

The committee of The All Ireland Golden Retriever Club shall be the show committee within the meaning of The Irish Kennel Club rules and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the committee. Parties to any such disputes shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES AT BREED CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

(All age classes computed from date of birth.)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. (.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Adult Class Is For Dogs Between 24 And 36 Calendar Months Of Age On The First Day Of the Show

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.***

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth..

Field Trial Class is confined to dogs who have won at least a reserve in a Puppy, Novice, Derby or Open Stake as defined in the Field Trial Rules & Regulations.

PLEASE NOTE CAREFULLY:

- (a) Dogs under 4 months of age are not eligible to compete at this Show.
- (b) (b) All dogs entered for this Show must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor.
- (c) (c) A Veteran dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both
- (d) A Dog or bitch may be entered in one breed class only (no double entries)

CATALOGUE

Exhibitors who are members will receive a free catalogue on show day. Otherwise catalogues must be prepaid with entry; there will be no catalogues for sale on show day

Covid-19 Guidelines

- This document should be read in conjunction with the “IKC pathway back to dog shows within Irish government Covid-19 guidelines. This document is available from the IKC website.
- General Information
- If an exhibitor or anyone in their household has covid-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for covid-19, they must self-isolate in line with government advice. The exhibitor must NOT attend this event.
- Face Mask/face covering will be required when entering the show ring and all areas except for your POD.
- All entries must be made Online.
- Catalogues must be prepaid and will be available along with the ring numbers on the day of the show.
- Where possible exhibitors should only handle dogs from their own household.
- **Covid-19 Declaration forms must be completed and handed in before entry to the show venue. Collections points will be available at the entrance to the venue. This declaration is available in this show schedule or on the IKC website.**
- **Tents/ Pods**
- **All exhibitors must indicate if they require a tent/Pod space.** Spaces will be allocated on the day and will be 3mtrs square with 2mtrs between each tent.
- Tents will only be allowed within their designated space.
- Pod spaces will be available **for crates and chairs only**. Each pod will be 2mtrs square with 2 mtr spacing.
- Tents/Pods must only be used by the allocated family/travelling pod.
- There will be no seating around the show ring.
- **Sanitisation stations**
- Sanitisation stations will be at various locations within the venue.
- Entrance to venue.
- Collecting rings.
- Judges tent.
- Secretaries tent.
- Judging ring.
- **Catering facilities**
- There will be no catering facilities available on the day of the show.
- Car Parking
- Car parking will be available within the designated car park only.

- **Judging**
- Exhibitor's will collect in the collecting ring before entering the main ring.
- 2Mtr spaces will be marked and should be observed by the exhibitor in the collecting ring, main ring and collection area.
- Entrance and Exit will be clearly marked and must be observed by all exhibitors.
- The judge shall wear a face mask/covering and sanitise his/her hands between each dog judged.
- The exhibitor must show the dogs bite to the judge.
- The judge will complete his/her own paperwork.
- It may be necessary for dogs to be in the ring on rotation if the ring is not large enough to accommodate all exhibits in ne go with social distancing.
- All exhibitors must wear a face mask/covering in the ring.
- Where possible exhibitors should only handle dogs from their own pod.
- No hair dryers / blasters allowed.
- All PPE and rubbish must be disposed of correctly.
- There will be no Children's handling, Best head and expression or parade of champions.
- **Entry**
- There will be committee members / Marshals available to show people to their tents/pods.
- Only those entered to the show will be allowed to gain entry.
- Please note, as per restrictions, children must always be supervised at all times. Children will not be allowed within the proximity of the main ring.
- Failure to comply will result in severe repercussions, removal from the show or award being withheld.
- All of the above are now deemed to be additional requirements for shows and will fall under the IKC disciplinary rules until further notice.
- As and when government covid guidelines are lifted the board of the IKC will review same.
- **Please note that you will need to print and fill out the covid track & trace form and bring it with you to the show. This can be handed into the collection point upon entry to the venue. Admittance will not be granted without this form**
