Dogs must be under control at all times. No dogs to be left tied up or unsupervised.

Fouling

The Owner / Handler of any dog found fouling anywhere at the venue will be subject to a fine of €25.00

Pet Passports Travel between Ireland and the UK.

The following is taken from the Department of Agriculture website –

Accompanied pets must have an Animal Health Certificate AHC, certifying (1) microchip identification and (2) subsequent rabies vaccination with first vaccination at least 21 days before entry into Ireland. Dogs must also be treated for the tapeworm echinococcus unless travelling into Ireland directly from another Echinococcus free country ie the UK, Malta, Finland and Norway Full details on www.agriculture.gov.ie/pets

SHOW REGULATIONS

1. The show will be held under the Licence, Rules & Regulations of the IK C. Lid.
2. The show will be held at Ferry House Sports Complex, Waterford Road, Clonmel County Tipperary.
3. The entry fees will be as follows: ENTRIES CLOSE, 1st August 2022. First dog - €26.00 irrespective of the number of classes entered. Second dog & subsequent dogs in same ownership €10
4. The Jack Russell Terrier of Ireland reserve the right to refuse any entry
5. Dogs under 4 months of age are not eligible to enter.
6. All dogs must be registered or transferred with the IKC save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club. Failure to comply with the above will result in (a) the dog being disqualified from the event AND (b) the exhibitor being fined €127. the implementation of which shall be a normal office routine. All appeals to the Irish Kennel Club should carry a fee of €6 refundable if the appeal is upheld.
7. All wins prior to the day specified for the closing of entries shall be taken into account when entering any class
8. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class
9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show grounds is forbidden
10. ***Judging will commence after judging of breed at Clonmel Show.*** In the event of any judge failing to keep his/her engagement, the committee of Jack Russell Club of Ireland shall have the right to appoint another judge No person will be allowed in the judging ring except the judge, show officials or an exhibitor taking a dog in for adjudication. The exhibit number for each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler. The Jack Russell Terrier Club of Ireland shall not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring
11. Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping their dog under proper control at all times
12. The catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms and while every effort will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted, the committee cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes, which bring the exhibitor within the purview of the IKC Ltd. Rule 15 section 1, or for clerical errors that may occur during compilation
13. Exhibitors must clean up if their dog fouls the grounds, suitable facilities will be provided for this. Any exhibitor failing to clean up after their dog will be liable to a €25 fine.
14. Jack Russell Club of Ireland will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show
15. Ring numbers will be distributed at the show

CLASS DEFINITIONS

A Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 4 and less than 6 months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition except Best Baby Puppy in Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs of 6 months and under the age of 12 months on the day of the Show.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show.

Champion Class is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Limited rules or under another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show. Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)
