Show Rules, Regulations & Instructions to Exhibitors

 Jurisdiction: The Show will be held under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. As in force on August 20th 2024.

Venue- St. Brendan's College Sports Field, Port Road, Killarney

 Service Charges: First entry €27.00 (£27.00 STG.) 1st dog, IKC Levy €1.00, additional entries of same or different dogs €10.00 (£10.00 Stg.)

There will be an additional charge of €8.00 (£8.00 Stg) each for the Puppy Stakes, Brace Stakes, Team Stakes. To enter in the above Stakes Classes Exhibits must be entered in breed classes. Champion Stakes, Veteran Stakes €8.00 (£8.00 Stg.)(Entry in breed classes not required.). Junior Handling: €5.00 (£5.00 stg.) per dog if not entered in Breed free if entered in Breed.

Dogs Not for Competition €5.00 each

- 4. (a) Rejection of Entries: The committee reserve the right to reject any entry, advertisement or any other insertion in the Catalogue or the allocation of stand space at the show.
 - **(b) Ineligible Entries:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to the sex or breed may be allowed if reported to the secretary's office <u>prior</u> to the commencing of judging. A dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to an open class in that breed, but in no other respects.

No other changes allowed

- 5. Registrations: All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 36, Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without futher registration.
- 6. ENTRY FORMS: MISTAKES IN- The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.

LEGIBILITY IS OF PRIME IMPORTANCE.

- SERVICE CHARGE FORFEITURE.: Those failing to arrive before closing date or those exhibits rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon.
- Prizes Withheld: A judge shall be empowered to withhold any prize, or Green Stars if in his or her opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
- Special Prizes: Where special prizes are offered for competition by or through a Specialist Club the Specialist Club will be responsible for the collection and distribution of the prizes
- DISQUALIFICATION: All prize monies and other awards must be returned immediately to the Hon. Sec. on notification from the Irish Kennel Club
- 11. Veterinary Examination: Any Veterinary Surgeon acting with the authority of the Show Committee may have any dog removed from the Show if: (i) suspected cause of infection or contagious disease; (ii) totally blind or deaf; (iii) castrated (iv)vicious or savage disposition. If requested by the Show Secretary, the Veterinary Surgeon shall give such order in writing, together with the reason for it.

- 12. Judges: If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her engagement, the Committee reserve the right to employ another judge. The right is reserved to the Show Committee to change a judge in breed or breeds, or part of a breed, if it is considered such a change is in the best interests of the show.
- 13. Judging: Will commence at 9.30 am. sharp, Junior Handling at 9.00 a.m.
 No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late. No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.
 Exhibitors will not be allowed to wear a badge or other decoration, in the Breed Judging Ring save for the exhibition number of each dog which must be clearly displayed by his handler.
- 14. Protests: All protests must be made in the manner specified in the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club.
- 15. Responsibility: Exhibitors will please understand that while every reasonable precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of the exhibits, (a) The Killarney and District Canine Club will not be responsible for loss or damage sustained by an exhibitor through accident or otherwise. (b) The Promoting Body will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to any exhibitor or other person attending the show (c) Visitors are requested not to handle the dogs sent for exhibition.
- 16. (All announcements appearing in any Daily Newspaper or other publication, or online in reference to any alterations made by the Show Committee in the Schedule or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice there of.
- 17. INTERPRETATION: The Committee of this Club shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Rules and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any such disputes shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club.
- **18. Stands:** Sales of any article will only be permitted from a duly licensed stands. (Anywhere on the Grounds) Current Copies Of Public Liability Insurance must be lodged with secretary.
- 19. Car Park: €5.00 (£5.00 Stg) All Parking Must Be Prepaid. The club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to vehicles within the venue, whether accidental or otherwise. €10.00/£10.00Stg Campers/DormobilesVoucher must be relinquished to Gate man.
- 20. Pre-Paid Catalogues: Voucher must be downloaded from Dogshowentry, and given to Catalogue seller. Remittance of €5.00 (£5.00Stg)with entries ensures a catalogue, <u>AS THOSE ON GENERAL SALE WILL BE LIMITED</u>. ON SHOW DAY €6.00 (£6.00Stg) (Catalogue not collected by 11.00 am may be sold)
- 21. Order of Judging: All judges are requested to take the breeds and classes in the order in which they appear in the Schedule and Judging Book, unless a change is deemed necessary by the Committee, Dogs must be placed 1st to 4th left to right in Breed Classes, Groups and Best in Show. All exhibits must be graded verbally and exhibitors advised of the grade by the judge on the day of the show.
- 22. SHOW OPEN: AT 8 AM. ADMISSION ADULTS €5.00, CHILDREN MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT
- 23. FOULING: A fine of €20 will be imposed on the owner/handler of a dog which fouls/soils in the immediate precinct of the show. It behoves us all to be litter conscious and to clean up after ourselves. Surely this not too much to ask.
- **24. DOUBLE HANDLING,** the judge officiating will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
- 26. Exercise/Puppy Pens: are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, at all shows licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.
- 27. Dogs not entered for competition: Dogs which are not being exhibited at all Breed Championship Shows must be entered as NOT FOR COMPETITION, for insurance purposes, prior to close of entries.

Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of breed/s and name/s of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs and keep a record of same. Production of passes may be requested in any area of dispute. The fee for this facility shall be **Five Euro**, (£5.00), per dog.

RULES FOR JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

- 1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
- 2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
- No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
- 4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
- 5. Groups will be divided into ten sections as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
- 6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
- In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
- 8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
- 9. If the Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €100 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences. A Group Winner failing to report for the Best in Show will incur a fine of €100 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified) (effective from the 1st January 2011)

Breeds Not Separately Listed

Breeds entered in the Breeds Not Separately Listed at National Championship Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the Catalogue. A Judge may award a Green Star and Best of Breed in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded excellent or in the case of puppies "Very Promising" Effective from 1st January 2011.

Cropped Dogs

Cropped dogs are not permitted to be exhibited at any Irish Kennel Club licenced event.

PLEASE NOTE: Dogs who have gained their Championship Title under English Kennel Club rules ought to be described as G.B. Ch. on Entry Form

AKITA EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds American Akita and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed)

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

We suggest that they are placed last in the order of judging, as the judge on the day will have to be absent from the ring during the assessment. It is envisaged that the number of unassessed dogs will decrease over the next six months and eventually all Akitas will be designated as American Akita or Akita Inu.

VIDEO/CAMERAS

It is a Kennel Club Regulation that permission must be sought from the Show Promoting Body for the use of Video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the Judge in the Ring on the day.

NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED

N.B.:

Please send entries on time and with sufficient postage to ensure delivery on time.

Many Entries last year failed to arrive on time due to insufficient postage.

Groups will be judged in the Main Ring NOT BEFORE 2.00pn.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RIGHTS

The organisers would like to bring the regulation of photography and filming to the attention of exhibitors, trade stands, press and visitors.

It is a condition of all those attending the event that no filming or other form of recording may be taken or made at the venue without express written permission of the organisers. The taking of photographs in the show venue for sale or reward is strictly prohibited **EXCEPT WITH THE WRIITEN PERMISSION OF THE ORGANISERS.** Press accredited photographers are provided with permission to take photographs ONLY for use in newspapers, magazines and internet sites-this is for news purposes only. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs of general views of the show, provided that these are for private use. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor. No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Green Star is awarded. Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the rings at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash unit is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned.

All Gundog Breeds have Field Trial Dog and Bitch classes CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award other than Best Baby Puppy in Show.

Minor Puppy Class is confined to puppies of six months and under nine months of age on the first day of the show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show,

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.****

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

FIELD TRIAL CLASS is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stake.

.Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in <u>ONE BREED CLASS ONLY</u> (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

TEAM CLASS is for three or more exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

Neuter Class;

The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.

Special Beginners Stakes:

A new stakes class to help promote newcomers to the scene and also to encourage some competing in the more numerically strong breeds. To be eligible to compete, neither the owner/handler or the dog will have won a Green Star prior to the entry closing date of the show. This class can be offered at any show. This is judged on the quality of the dog and placings are 1-4 as in the other stakes classes. The organising Show Society decide the prizes they wish to offer (and if they want to charge an entry fee. In the event that a dog is co owned, all owners must fulfil the criteria).

You cannot enter this group online, you must qualify on the day by winning Best of Breed in your respective Irish Native Breed.







