1. The show will be held under licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. All exhibitors are deemed to be knowledgeable of these and the Club will not be responsible for any omission that may bring an exhibitor within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club.

Venue: The show will be held at the **Lurgan Park, Lurgan, Co. Armagh BT66 7BD. Entrance only from Avenue Road A3 Gate**

1. Judging will commence at 2.30 pm.

2. Entries Service Charge:

First dog €25.00 (£25.00 Stg) for first dog .

€10.00 (£10.00 Stg.) for each subsequent dog registered to the same owner.

PLEASE NOTE

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over four and under six months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition

Restricted / Special Classes (i.e. Colour Classes etc) The dog must be entered in one of the standard classes scheduled for the breed, as above.

All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over four and under six months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.******

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

Restricted / Special Classes (i.e. Colour Classes etc) The dog must be entered in one of the standard classes scheduled for the breed, as above.
