## Meet Our Judge

The Irish Pug Dog Club is enormously pleased to welcome John Costner out of retirement for what he insists will be his last judging appointment. John, also known as Sam, is a pug specialist, well known for his Sammet affix. He has awarded Green Stars and Challenge Certificates at many notable shows including Birmingham and SKC.

John's first pug, Whiskey, was bought as a present for his wife. Bought as an adult and with only one eye, he was not a show pug. But as is often the case, he stole John's heart and the search for a show pug followed. He bought a very nice Paramin bitch from Margo Raisin, and managed to win two CCs and 5 reserve CCs. However, the third CC eluded him, so John decided to breed a litter from her instead. The resulting litter had two nice dog pups. One of them, Sammet Paul of Paramin, was sold to Marjorie Shriver in the US. John says that this was the best pug he ever bred. He became a US Champion in only six weeks, sired 46 champions, and had a grandson that went on to become Top Toy in Mexico for two years. Clearly the Sammet line has had a big influence on American pugs.

Another pug that stands out for John was a bitch that he bought from Nancy Tarbitt, Nanchyl Tabitha, that became his first GB Champion.

After his wife died, John stopped showing. He is now retired from the scene and has just one pet pug. We are delighted that he has agreed to come out of retirement to judge our Club Show.

## SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **JURISDICTION.** The show will be held under licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. As in force on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022.
2. **All dogs must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.**  
**Venue:** the show will be held at The Ulster Flying Club, Co. Down on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2022. Between the hours of 9am and 6pm judging will commence at 12 noon. Entries will be received up to and including **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> August 2022** by the **secretary: Ms. Gillian Stewart, Garryowen, Killacloran, Aughrim, Co. Wicklow. Tel: 089 453 7415**
3. The promoting body shall have the right to refuse any entry.  
**Online closes at midnight on the 19<sup>th</sup> August 2022**
4. **ENTRIES-ENTRY FEE of €22 for first entry and €5 for each dog thereafter.**
5. **There will be an entry fee of €3 per dog for dogs entered in all stakes classes. Dogs Not for competition €5.00**
6. **No entries will be accepted without the appropriate fees, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.**
7. **JUDGING** - If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her appointment, the committee reserves to employ another judge. The right is reserved to the promoting body to change in a breed if it is considered such a change is in the best interests of the show.
8. The promoting body shall not be responsible for the exhibition of any dog in the ring. In the event of an exhibitor requesting a Steward or other official to handle his or her exhibit in the ring, any such official may voluntarily do so but on the distinct understanding that such an action is on behalf of the owner and does not involve the promoting body in any responsibility whatever for loss or damage consequential or otherwise.
9. **JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT 12 NOON SHARP.**  
**CATALOGUES** - The promoting body shall not be responsible for any loss, direct or indirect, occasioned by any mistake or omission in the Catalogue. In any such case the exhibitor should immediately inform the ring Steward if the judging is in progress and otherwise the exhibitor should immediately report the Catalogue inaccuracy at the Secretary's Office.

10. **Announcements:** All announcements appearing on social media (Irish Exhibitors Choice & Voice on Facebook) prior to the date of the closing of entries and in reference to any alterations made by the promoting body in the Schedule or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
11. **EXHIBITS** - Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibit under proper control at all times. **ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES ANYWHERE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.**
12. **INTERPRETATION** - The committee of the promoting club shall be the " Show Committee" within the meaning of The Irish Kennel Club rules, and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to The Irish Kennel Club.

13. **ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE** - The Society will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the Show through accident or otherwise.
14. **FOULING** - Every exhibitor will be required to remove and dispose in bins provided any fouling made by their dogs in any part of the show grounds.
15. **EXHIBITORS ARE REQUESTED TO BRING THEIR OWN SCOOP OR PLASTIC BAG FOR THIS PURPOSE.**
16. **JUDGING RING** - No person will be allowed in any judging ring except the judge Show Official or exhibitor taking dogs in for adjudication.

**DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES**

*Please keep in mind I.K.C. Rule, if your dog fouls the venue indoor or outdoor and you do not clean it up you will be fined €25. This year's committee will strictly enforce this rule.*

*Save yourself money and clean up after your dog, and at the same time you will be assured of a comfortable venue to show your dog next year.*

### **The Classes below are to be judged after Best in Show**

Special Classes: Special Beginners Stakes, Special Open Black Dog,    Special Open Black Bitch  
Brace Stakes, Team Stakes, Fancy Dress, Neutered Dog/Bitch

Note: With the exception of the Fancy Dress and Neuter Classes, A pug must be entered in a BREED CLASS before it can enter a Special Class.

### **CLASS DEFINITIONS**

**(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)**

**Baby Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over four and under six months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition

**A Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show .

**A Minor Puppy Class** is confined to dogs of 6 months and under the age of 9 months on the day of the Show.

**A Junior Class** is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, .

**An Intermediate Class** is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, .

**An Adult class** is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show

**An Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, .

**A Champions Class** is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.**\*\*\*\*

**A Veteran Class** is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

**Neutered Class:** The class can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title

**A Brace Class** is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

**A Team Class** is for three exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

\*\*\*\* **Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**\*\*

**N.B.:** A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

**NOTE:** Entrants in Special Colour Classes inclusive must also be entered in one of the Main classes

**NOTE:** Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds unless entered in scheduled Baby Puppy Class. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.
