SHOW REGULATIONS

Jurisdiction: The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd as in force on the 11th of May 2024.

VENUE: The Show will be held at the National Show Centre, Cloghran, Co. Dublin

REGISTRATION: All dogs entered for competition with the Irish Kennel Club. Entries will only be accepted from exhibitors with dogs registered with another FCI member country if accompanied by the copies of the registration documents and also the relevant certificates for entry into the Working or Champions classes. These documents must be forwarded to the Show Secretary.

ENTRY FEES: €25 for First Dog €15 for subsequent Dogs in same ownership and €5 per dog Stakes Classes. Postal entries will be accepted up to and including **(12th April 2024)**. The Committee reserve the right to reject any entry, advert or other insertion in the Catalogue.

PRIZES: Rosettes will be given to Best in Show, Reserve Best in Show, Green Star Dog, Green Star Bitch, Reserve Green Star Dog, Reserve Green Star Bitch, Best Puppy in Show, Best Baby Puppy in Show, Best Veteran in Show, Best Neuter in Show and First, Second, Third and Reserve in each class.

JUDGING: Judging will commence at 12 Noon sharp. Should the appointed Judge fail to keep their appointment, the Committee reserve the right to appoint a suitable substitute. No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late. No person will be allowed in the judging ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or any exhibitor taking their Dog in for adjudication. a) No person will be allowed in the Judging ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an Exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. b) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring. c) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring at the time of judging.

Judges Decision: The decision of a judge at the termination of his or her judging a class shall be final, except in the case of an objection properly made and upheld under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., where a judge states that a clerical or other mistake was made in an award as Officially returned, or on the ground of fraud.

CATALOGUES: The promoting body shall not be responsible for any loss, direct or indirect occasioned by any mistake or omission in the Catalogue. Such mistake should be reported to the ring Steward if judging is in progress, otherwise the exhibitor should report the inaccuracy to the Secretary immediately. A Catalogue will be issued to each exhibitor, free of charge. Protest: all protests and objections must be made in the manner specified in Irish Kennel Club Ltd. Rules 13, 15, 17.

Interpretation: The Committee of the Promoting Club shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. rules, and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd..

ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE: The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits exhibitors or other persons attending the show.

DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES NOTE:

I.K.C. RULE 7 Section 1

Re: Registration of Dogs Entered Addition to above Rule:

Failure to comply with the above will result in:

(a) The Dog being disqualified from the event and

(b) The exhibitor being fined €130.00

The implementation of which shall be a Normal (I.K.C.) Office routine

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW, AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN ON THE ENTRY FORM.

Videos: It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day. (Subject to Regulation 12 page 1)

DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES

Please keep in mind I.K.C. Rule, if your dog fouls the venue indoor or outdoor and you do not clean it up you will be fined €25. This year's committee will strictly enforce this rule.

Save yourself money and clean up after your dog, and at the same time you will be assured of a comfortable venue to show your dog next year.

Dogs:

The Classes below are to be judged after Best in Show

Special Classes: Special Beginners Stakes, Special Open Black Dog, Special Open Black Bitch
Brace Stakes, Team Stakes, Fancy Dress, Neutered Dog, Neutered Bitch

A Special Open Black Class: is for black dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show.

Beginners Stakes: To be eligible to compete in this class, neither the owner, handler or dog will have won a Green Star prior to the entry closing date of the Show. In the event of co-owned dogs, all owners must fulfil the criteria. This class is judged on the quality of the dog.

Fancy Dress: Open to all pugs that have been entered in a breed class. This class is judged on the originality and entertainment factor of the pug's costume.

Note: With the exception of the Fancy Dress and Neuter Classes, A pug must be entered in a BREED CLASS before it can enter a Special Class.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over four and under six months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show .

A Minor Puppy Class is confined to dogs of 6 months and under the age of 9 months on the day of the Show.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, .

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, .

An Adult class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, .

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.******

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

Neutered Class: The class can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title

A Brace Class is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

A Team Class is for three exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

**** Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

NOTE: Entrants in Special Colour Classes inclusive must also be entered in one of the Main classes

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds unless entered in scheduled Baby Puppy Class. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.
