Irish Kennel Club Requirements for Overseas Exhibitors

The Irish Kennel Club Ltd. - being a full member of the F.C.I. has claified its requirements for entry of exhibits at dog shows held in Ireland, under licence of the ish Kennel Club Ltd., as follows:-

FCI Member Countries:-

Exhibits whose pedigrees are registered with their country's FCI recognised Kennel Club will *not* be required to register with the I.K.C. in or-der to exhibit at I.K.C. licenced shows in Ireland.

However, they *must* present, for examination at ring entry, their Kennel Club registration papers.

In addition, exhibits must also present their Championship documentation for examination, for entry into Champions Class.

Non - FCI Member Countries:-

Exhibits from non-FCI countries *must* be registered with their own Kennel Club (*FCI approved* and registered with the Irish Kennel Club in order to enter and exhibit at dog shows held in Ireland under licence of the Irish Kennel Club.

e.g. United Kingdom, USA, Canada, etc.

Show Regulations

- 1: Jurisdiction: The Show will be held under licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- 2: Registration: All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. (Fottrell House, Harold's ross Bridge, Dub n 6 W)
- 3: Venue: The Show will be held at the National Show Centre, Cloghran, Dublin on 3rd August 2025
- 4: Entry Fees: The entry fee will be based on the following scale:-

(Figures in brackets denote Sterling)

1st. Entry € 20 (£20)

(Includes catalogue)

2nd. and subsequent Entries € 10 (£10) per entr

No Self onversions Stg / Euro wi e accepted.

Fees of ex ibitors arriving late or f iling to ar ive or rejected on vete inary grounds will be forfeited. No en ies will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge ich cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

Rejecting Entr es: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue or allocation of stand spa e at the show.

Ineligible Entries: A dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may only be transferred to the appropriate Open Class in its breed, except in the case of an incorrect entry as to sex, when the Show Secretary may, prior to the commencement of judging, permit the transfer of s h an entry to the appropriate sex.

Entry Forms (mista es): The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms mitted by exhibitors and while every endeavour wie made to have forms orrectly interpreted, the promoting body cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring the exhibitor within the purview of the I.K.C. (Rule 15 – ection 1) or for clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.

5: Rosettes will e awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Reserve in each class. Rosettes will also be awarded to Green Star winners, Best in Show, Reserve Best in Show, Best Puppy and Best Veteran.

- **6: Veterinary Examination:** The Veterinary S rgeon on call will have the power to exclude any exhibit which in his nion is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of disease, vice or other cause.
- 7: Exhibits: (a) Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times.
- (b) Every exhibit must be removed b the owner or agent not later than 6
- 8: Judging: Judging will comence at 12 noon. No claim hall e considered in the event of ny exhibit being 1 te.
- (a) No erson will be allowed in the Judging R ng except the Judge, Show Officials, r an Exhibitor taking the dog for adjudication.
- **(b)** The exhibition number must be clearly displated big the handler, who shall not wear a big or other decoration in the judging ring.
- (c) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring at the time of judg ng.
- **9:** Ac ident or Dama e: The Promoting Body will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
- 10: All Announcements appearing on the RR Club of Ireland website (http://rhodesian-ridgeback-club-reland.org/news.html) prior to the date of clos ng of entries and in reference to any a terations m e by the committee in the schedule or in these regulations shall e deemed sufficient notice thereof.
- **11: Interpretation:** The Organising C ttee for the breed championship how hall be the Show Committee as defined by the I.K.C. Rules. All disputes shall have right of appeal to The Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- 12: **Double Handling:** The judge officiating wil not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being a ted in its performance by any person other than the handler.

Class Definitions

(The word "dog" denotes both sexes)

In the following definitions any award which counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of ny governing b recognised by the Irish Kennel Clu wil e regarded as the equivalent of a Green Star. Similarly, the title of Champion is construed as if it were obtained under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award other than Best Baby Puppy in Breed

Puppy Class: is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Junior Class: is for dogs over nine months and under eighteen months of e on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Intermediate Class: is for dogs etween 15 and 24 calendar months of e on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Adult Class: is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Open Class: is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Champion Class: is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under I.K.C. Rules, or under a recognised Kennel Authority *confirmed by the date of closing of entries**

Veteran Class: is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

*Please note a Veteran exhibit who is a champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class, but not both.

Notes

A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY

The Classes below are to be judged after Best in S w:

Special Classes: Best Head, Best Movement, Best Ridge

Neuter Classes: Neutered Dog, Neutered Bitch - winners of Neuter Classes cannot compete for Green Stars

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds unless entered in s eduled Baby Puppy Class.

All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

Exhibitors Please Note:

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
No Dogs allowed in the catering / bar areas
All Exhibitors are required to bring a poop scoop / plastic bag.
Please cooperate fully with the Stewards.

Fouling

Please keep in mind the Irish Kennel Club rule, if your dog fouls the venue indoor or out and you do not clean it up, you will be fined €25. Save yourself money and clean up after your dog and at the same time you will be assured of a comfortable venue to show your dog next year.

Videos

It is an I.K.C. regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day

Please note a Veteran exhibit who is a champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class, but not both.

Club Trophies, Cups and Shields etc are awarded to in-benefit Club Members only, with the exception of the Rocksham Cup for Best in Show which is available to all exhibits. Club Trophies, Cups and Shields etc are not permitted to be taken out of the island of Ireland.

Ring Numbers will be distributed at the show.

Special classes will e run after BIS has been awarded. (Open to all who have entered the breed classes)

Exercise / Puppy Pens.

Exercise Pens / Puppy ens are prohibited, ithin the confines of e exhibition area, at **all shows** licensed by e Irish Kennel club, with effect from 1st January 2009

2) Dogs Not Entered For Competition.

Dogs which are not being exhibited at all breed championship shows must e entered as **Not for competition**, for insurance purposes, prior to close of entries.

Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of breeds and name of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes

to such dogs and keep a record of same. Production of passes may then be requested in any area of ispute. The fee for this facility shall be €5 per dog.

Puppies under the age of 6 months should not be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy is scheduled.

3) Incident Book

All show promoting societies are required to have an incident book in which any accidents, thefts reported to them or complaints lodged with the show society, a inst any person or persons must be recorded. A copy of which must be submitted to the Irish Kennel Club with the show returns. The Show nspector to confirm the presence of an Incidence Book ith the Show ecretary.

4) Show Inspectors

- a) The Show Inspector will bring to e attention of the show promoting society, on the day of the show, any areas that require immediate or urgent attention such as Excessively slippery areas due to rainfall, spillages or toilet facilities which require attention etc. it will be for the Show Management team to see that these areas are dealt with as quickly as possible and how such problems are to be resolved, however any show society which does not deal with such problems may face a fine or sanction from the Irish Kennel Clu Ltd.
- b) To bring to e attention of the show promoting society any transgressions from the Kennel Club procedures during jud ing such as exhibits not receiving grading cards immediately as essment, exhibits not being placed first to fourth, left to right etc., and requests are corrected immediately by the show management team.
- c) To bring to e attention of the show romoting society any dogs, s ch as young puppies, which are not being exhibited at e show and request that the show society investigate the matter. Should ny dogs not be entered for "competition" or "not for competition" the Show Society should ask that such dogs be removed from the venue.
