SHOW REGULATIONS

Applicable Rules- The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., as in force on the day of the publication of this schedule. **All Dogs must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.**

Venue: The Show will be held at: CJ Kickhams GAA Centre, Bawnavona, Mullinahone, Co. Tipperary.E41 R6P7

Date: Sunday 23rd October, 2022

1. Entry Fees: The Entry Fee will be:

€8.00 for first dog. Club members **€4**,

€4.00 for each subsequent dog. Club members **€2**,

€6.00 for all Stakes Classes and Junior Handling

Junior handling classes are free if the dog is entered in breed classes,

Catalogues - €2

Club members are those registered as such on the 31st August 2022,

Entries payable on dogshowentry.ie.

2. Postal Entries (incl. those from club members) will be received on or before 10th October 2022 (by postmark)

3. Enter online at www.dogshowentry.ie

Online closes at midnight on the 14th October 2022

4. Rejecting Entries: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, advertisement, or other insertion in the catalogue.

5. Ineligible Entries: If before judging of a Class or Classes in which his dog is entered, an exhibitor reports that he has entered the dog in a Class for which he is not eligible, he may be permitted to transfer his entry to the **Open Class** but in no other circumstances can a change be made.

6. The Show Committee will not accept any responsibility for mistakes in the Catalogue which may bring exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.

7. The Entry Fees of exhibits failing to arrive or rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon will be forfeited.

8. Junior Handlers: The dog must be the bona fide property of the family of the junior handler. Nominate the junior handler on the entry form also his/her age. The age of the handler on the 1st January is the age to be taken for the rest of the year when entering.

9. JUDGES: In the event of any appointed Judge failing to keep his or her appointment, the committee reserves the right to appoint another Judge or Judges. Exhibitors will be notified of any change in as timely a manner as circumstances permit.

10. Judging:

(1) The judging will commence at **11am – Junior Handlers**, and **1130am – all breeds**. No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late.

(2) No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.

(3) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by his handler who shall not wear badge or other decoration in the judging ring.

(4) Under no circumstances may the order of judging as provided for in the Catalogue be departed from without the expressed authorisation of the Club Secretary.

11. CATALOGUES - The Promoting Body shall not be responsible for any loss, direct or indirect, occasioned by any mistake or omission in the Catalogue. In any such case the exhibitor should immediately inform the ring steward, if the judging is in progress, otherwise the exhibitor should immediately report the Catalogue inaccuracy at the Secretary's Office. Catalogues will be available on-line.

12. ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE - The promoting club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the Show through accident or otherwise.

13. NOTICE - All announcements appearing in the Dog column of the Dublin Papers (Evening Edition) prior to the date of the closing of entries and in reference to any alterations made by the Promoting Body in the Schedule or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.

14. Please keep in mind the IKC Rule, if your dog fouls the venue, indoor or outdoor and you fail to clean it up you will be fined €25. Adequate supplies of appropriate cleaning equipment will be available for use if required.

The Committee will be strictly enforcing this Rule.

15. EXHIBITORS ARE DEEMED TO BE FULLY AQUAINTED WITH AND ARE SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE IRISH KENNEL CLUB LTD., ALL DOGS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE I. K. C.

16. RING NUMBERS HANDED OUT ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW.

ADJACENT PLAYING SURFACE IS STRICTLY OUT OF BOUNDS!!!
NO EXERCISING OF DOGS ON THE PLAYING SURFACE OF THE ADJACENT GAA PITCHES, OR ON THE WALKING TRACK THAT BORDERS THE PLAYING PITCHES.

Disabled Parking.

Disabled parking is available to holders of a valid Disabled Parking Permit. Application must be made directly to the Club Secretary including vehicle registration. Parking permit must be displayed on vehicle on the day – no permit, no preferential parking.



CLASS DEFINITIONS (The word 'Dog' is GENDER NEUTRAL)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 4 and under 6 months of age on the day of the Show.

Puppy Class/Stakes is confined to dogs from six to twelve months of age on the day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Champion Stakes is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

Veteran Stakes is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in **ONE BREED CLASS ONLY** (No double entries)

CLASSIFICATION FOR ALL BREEDS WHERE APPLICABLE.

Dogs: Baby Puppy, Puppy, Junior, Adult, Intermediate, Open, Champion, Veteran

Bitches: Baby Puppy, Puppy, Junior, Adult, Intermediate, Open, Champion, Veteran

**** A veteran dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Champion or Veteran class – but not both.**

Junior Handling Classes 10—12 yrs. 13—14 yrs. 15—17 yrs.
