Show Rules, Regulations and Instructions to Exhibitors

1. **The Show** will be held under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.

Venue- The Show will be held **Holycross GAA Grounds, Holycross, Thurles, Co. Tipperary E41 NH26 . on Saturday, 29th April 2023**

1. **Entry Fee**

4. **Exhibits must be entered in breed classes with the exception of Veteran/Champion.**

5. **Entries will be received up to the 31st March 2023. (Postmark)**

Online close at midnight on the 7th April 2023

UK exhibitors are to be reminded that postage must be correct or the entries will not arrive on time (Please add an 'E' stamp AND a blue air mail sticker).

6. **Entry Forms : Mistakes in-** The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the South Tipperary Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
7. **Rejection of Entries:** The committee reserve the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue.
8. **Ineligible Entries:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to the sex or breed is allowed if reported to the secretary's office prior to the commencing of judging. A dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the open class in that breed, but in no other respects.
9. **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition at this show must be registered at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 36, Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
10. **Prize Money:** Best in Show Winner €100, Reserve Best in Show €45, Prize money will be paid out on the day of the show. Prize cards will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Reserve in Class. Rosettes to B.O.B., Group Winners, Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show, Rosettes will also be given to Green Star Dog and Bitch, BOB, Reserve Group & Group Winners.
11. **Prizes Withheld;** A judge shall be empowered to withhold any prize, prizes, or Green Stars if in his or her opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
12. **During the exhibition of dogs,** the judge officiating will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in

its performance by any person other than the handler.

13. **Exhibits Not Sent:** Persons entering an exhibit or exhibits and failing to send them for exhibition or should their exhibit be rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon, will forfeit the entrance fees paid.
14. While efforts will be made by the Stewards to see that every eligible dog present at the show will be brought into the Ring when required for judging, the South Tipperary Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for the absence of any dog when the judging of a Breed or Class or Group is about to commence.
15. **Veterinary Examination:** Any Veterinary Surgeon acting with the authority of the Show Committee may have any dog removed from the Show if: (i) suspected cause of infection or contagious disease; (ii) totally blind or deaf; (iii) vicious or savage disposition.
16. **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his engagement the Committee shall have the right to fill the vacancy thus caused.
17. **Judging:** Obedience & Junior Handling will commence at 9.30am.
In all other rings Judging will commence at 10.00 a.m. sharp, and no claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by his handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring.
17. **Spectators:** Admission: €2.00.
18. **Interpretation:** The Guarantors of the South Tipperary Canine Club shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the I.K.C. Ltd. Rules and all disputes, if any, shall be dealt with by the committee. Parties to any disputes shall have right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
19. **The show will be open to the public from 7.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.**
20. **The Promoting Body** will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.
21. **Exercise/Puppy Pens:** are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, **at all shows** licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.
22. **Dogs not entered for competition:** Dogs which are not being exhibited at all Breed Championship Shows must be entered as **NOT FOR COMPETITION**, for insurance purposes, prior to close of entries. Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of breed/s and name/s of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs and keep a record of same. Production of passes may be requested in any area of dispute. The fee for this facility shall be **Five Euro, (€5.00), per dog.**
23. **Puppies under** the age of six (6) months **should not** be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.

Breeds Not Separately Listed (Unlisted Breeds)

Breeds entered in the Breeds Not Separately Listed at National Championship Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the Catalogue.

A Judge may award a Green Star and Best of Breed in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded excellent or in the case of puppies "Very Promising".with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified)

Cropped Dogs: Cropped dogs are not permitted to be exhibited at any Irish Kennel Club licenced event.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 6 and under 12 months of age on the day of the Show

Junior Class is confined to dogs over 9 and under 18 months of age on the day of the Show.

Intermediate Class is confined to dogs over 15 and under 24 months on the day of the Show.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show

Open Class is confined to dog over 15 months on the day of the Show.

Champion Class is confined to dogs that have attained the title of Champion under the Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or other Kennel Authority recognised by the Irish Kennel Club.

Veteran Class is confined to dog over 8 years of age on the day of the Show

Field Trial Class is confined to dogs who have won at least a reserve in a Puppy, Novice, Derby or Open Stake as defined in the Field Trial Rules & Regulations.

A copy of the relevant win at Field Trial must accompany the entry form.

Neutered Class

These classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, **BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.**

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

Brace Class is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor
Special Beginners Stakes;

A new stakes class to help promote newcomers to the scene and also to encourage some competing in the more numerically strong breeds. To be eligible to compete, neither the owner/handler or the dog will have won a Green Star prior to the entry closing date of the show. This class can be offered at any show. This is judged on the quality of the dog and placings are 1-4 as in the other stakes classes. The organising Show Society decide the prizes they wish to offer (and if they want to charge an entry fee. In the event that a dog is co owned, all owners must fulfil the criteria).

OBEDIENCE CLASS DEFINITIONS

Under General Rules

Food or any other article may not be given or carried in the ring, with the exception of Pre-Beginners and Beginners where a non-squeaky/non-audible toy may be carried by the handler.

PRE -BEGINNERS OBEDIENCE CLASS

Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded **three** first prizes (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Limited Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club Limited.

Handlers may carry a non-squeaky/audible toy in their hand or pocket and reward the dog by playing with that toy for up to 20 seconds at the end of each exercise with the exception of the stay test. The dog is not allowed to play with the toy during the exercise.

BEGINNERS OBEDIENCE CLASS

Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or awarded **four** or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks)) in any obedience test, other than Pre-Beginners Obedience Class, under Irish Kennel Club Limited Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club Limited. Handlers may carry a non-squeaky/non-audible toy in their hand or pocket and reward the dog by playing with that toy for up to 20 seconds at the end of each exercise with the exception of the stay test. The dog is not allowed to play with the toy during the exercise.

NOVICE OBEDIENCE CLASS

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience class other than in Beginners Obedience class.

CLASS A OBEDIENCE

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience Class other than in Beginners and Novice Obedience classes.

CLASS B OBEDIENCE

Old Rule:- Down five (5) minutes (30 points). Handler out of sight.

New Rule:- Down four (4) minutes (30 points). Handler out of sight.

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded a Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience Classes with the exception of Beginners, Novice or Class A Obedience.

CLASS (C) CH. OBEDIENCE (OPEN) Open to all.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Please Note:

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes

Best Native Breed in Show, (from ikc office) From 01/01/2022, the following must be classed at all the All Breed Championship Shows & International Shows.

Prior to the commencement of the Groups, there will be a competition for Best Native Breed in Show.

This will be open to the 9 Best of Breed winners in the Native Breeds on the day. The judge selected for this will not have judged any of the breeds on the day or will not be judging any of their relevant groups or the BIS later on in the day.

The judge will select 1,2,3,4. This result will have NO bearing on further competition in the Groups or BIS.

The Native Breeds will gain points based on these placings, i.e., 1st 4pts, 2nd 3pts, 3rd 2pt and 4th 1pt.

A leader board will be compiled during the year and awards given to the top winning Native Breed (s) under this system. The 1,2,3,4 in BIS at the Native Breeds Championship Show will also count towards this competition. **

Judges progressing to judge the Native Irish Breeds to be given consideration** *There is NO entry fee for this Group*

Breed Club Shows will not count. You cannot enter this group online, you must qualify on the day by winning Best of Breed in your respective Irish Native Breed.

The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; American Akita and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed))

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

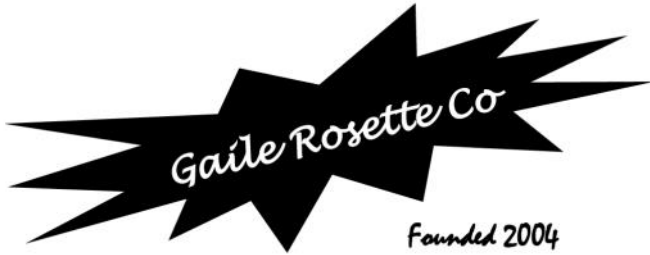
