SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Jurisdiction: The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club as in force on the 3rd September 2022
2. Registrations: All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 6, Greenmount Office Park Dublin 6
Venue: The Show will be held in the **Ulster Flying Club, Newtownards Airport 61 Portaferry Road Newtownards BT23 8SG.** on Saturday the 3rd September 2022
1. Entries: Service Charge: **€18.80/£16.00 first dog, and €10.58/£9.00 for each additional dog in the same ownership**
2. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate service charge which cannot be refunded under any circumstance
3. Entries will be received up to and including 13th August by the secretary Mrs Marion Gregg, 89 Moss Rd Carryduff Bt8 8hx
4. Online entries at www.dogshowentry.ie received until midnight 20th August 2022
5. Rejection of entries of entries The promoting body reserve the right to refuse any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue or the allocation of stand space at the show.
6. Entry forms Mistakes in Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by the exhibitors and while every endeavour will be made to have forms correctly interpreted the NITA cannot accept responsibility for mistakes which may bring exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club (rule 15 section 1) or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation
7. Ineligible entries A transfer of an incorrect entry as to the sex or breed is allowed if reported to the sec. office prior to the commencing of judging. A dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the open class in that breed but in no other respects
8. Rosettes will be given for GS, BOB, 1st to 4th in all classes and group specials
9. Group specials---BEST IN SHOW, BEST BABY PUPPY, BEST PUPPY, BEST JUNIOR, AND BEST VETERAN
10. Exhibits a Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times b Every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent within one hour of completion of judging
11. Judges I the event of the appointed judge failing to keep his or her engagement the committee shall have the right to appoint another judge
12. Judging a Will commence at 11.30am. No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late b No person will be allowed in the judging ring except the judge, show officials or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication c The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring d The club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring
13. All announcements appearing in the Canine press or social media prior to the closing of entries or in reference to any alterations in the schedule or in these regulations will be deemed sufficient notice thereof
14. Interpretation The committee of the promoting body will be the show committee within the meaning of the IKC rules. All disputes if any shall be dealt by the committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the IKC
15. Accident or Damage: The club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accidents by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
16. Exercise/ puppy pens: are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area at all shows licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from 1st Jan 2009
17. Puppies under 6 months of age should not be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a baby puppy class is scheduled.

Note Addition to I.K.C. Rule 17 sect 1

Every dog exhibited or competing at any show, field trial or obedience test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds with up to date registrations from the Irish Coursing Club and dogs of a not recognised breed for which license has been approved for obedience, agility or working tests. Failure to comply with the above will result in (A) The dog being disqualified from the event, (B) The exhibitor being fined £127.00 The implement of which shall be a normal I.K.C Office routine

PLEASE ENSURE YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION NUMBER ON THE ENTRY FORM.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Breeds not separately listed.

Breeds entered in Breeds not separately listed at Nation Ch Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the catalogue. A judge may award a Green Star and BOB in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded Excellent or in the case of puppies “Very Promising”

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 4 and under 6 months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition except Best Baby Puppy In Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs from six to twelve months of age on the day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Adult class is confined to dogs between 24 and 36 months on the day of the show

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under the rules and regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show. Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)
