SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The show will be held under license and rules of the Irish Kennel Club as in force as on the day of this schedule
2. All dog entered must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club
3. Venue. The show will be held on Saturday 2nd September at the Ulster Flying Club, Newtownards Airport 61 Portaferry Road, Newtownards. BT23 8SG
4. **Entry fee €25.00 for first dog entered and €15.00 for each subsequent dog** entered by a single person or partnership as registered with the Irish Kennel Club
5. Online entries will be received up to 26th August 2024
6. The entry fee for any exhibit which fails to arrive or any exhibit failing a fitness test will be forfeited.
7. The show committee will not accept responsibility for mistakes in the catalogue which may bring any exhibitor within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club
8. Judges : In the event of the appointed judge failing to keep their appointment the Committee reserve the right to appoint
9. Show opens at 7.30 am
10. Judging will commence at 9.00 am and will follow the proposed judging order of Bangor Ch Show
11. No person will be allowed in the show ring except the judge, show officials and exhibitors handling a dog for adjudication. The exhibit number shall be clearly displayed by its handler who shall not wear any badge or decoration in the judging ring.
12. Catalogues The promoting body shall not be responsible for any loss, direct or indirect occasioned by any mistake or omission in the catalogue, Any such error shall be reported immediately to the ring steward or show secretary.
13. The officers or committee shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibitors or other persons attending the show through accident or otherwise.
14. PRIZE ROSETTES for the following
All Best of Breeds, Best in Show-1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th. Best Baby Puppy 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th. Best Puppy in Show 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, Best Junior in Show 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th. Breed classes 1st-4th
15. No Committee member nor their immediate family or dogs registered in their names will be exhibiting at this show
16. In the event of the appointed judge failing to keep this engagement or entries exceed allowed numbers the committee shall have the right to fill the vacancy.

Note Addition to I.K.C. Rule 17 sect 1

Every dog exhibited or competing at any show, field trial or obedience test must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds with up to date registrations from the Irish Coursing Club and dogs of a not recognised breed for which license has been approved for obedience, agility or working tests. Failure to comply with the above will result in (A) The dog being disqualified from the event, (B) The exhibitor being fined £127.00 The implement of which shall be a normal I.K.C Office routine

PLEASE ENSURE YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION NUMBER ON THE ENTRY FORM.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Breeds not separately listed.

Breeds entered in Breeds not separately listed at Nation Ch Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the catalogue. A judge may award a Green Star and BOB in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded Excellent or in the case of puppies "Very Promising"

OUR JUDGE

Robyn Price Killeen

I am currently a licensed ANKC judge for Groups 1 Toys, Group 2 Terriers, Group 3 Gundogs, Group 4 Hounds and Group 5 Working Dogs. I am currently training for Group 7 Non-Sporting and Group 6 Utility.

I am a retired Secondary School teacher but my love of education has not faded. I love learning about different breeds and supporting trainee judges with their learning also.

I co-founded and run a very popular Facebook page called Canine Construction and Conformation on Facebook with All Breeds judges Narelle Hammond, Duncan McCalister and Professor Brian Corbitt. This is an educational site that aids in supporting learning for trainee judges and extended learning for licensed judges using breeder input and breed focuses. We have over 22,000 members including breeders, judges and the President of the FCI

I have been involved in Fox Terrier Smooths for over 40 years and have bred over 100 Champions, Grand Champions, Supreme Champions, Best in Show and Specialty winners. I was fortunate to have many great terrier mentors when I started showing including the late All Breeds judge Mr. C E Milward of Grenpark fox terriers. He was an amazing mentor who taught me how to recognize breed type, quality and balance. He also taught me how to breed, groom and handle fox terriers

I have held the positions of President of the Smooth Fox Terrier club of Victoria, Vice President of the Sporting Terrier Club of Victoria and The President of the Maldon Kennel Club. Currently I am a committee member of the Ladies Kennel Club in Victoria.

I have judged Terrier Specialties in New South Wales, Tasmania, New Zealand and in the United States of America.

I have also judged the Fox Terrier Specialty and The Jack Russell Specialty Shows in NSW. My judging extends to multiple groups in Tasmania, Victoria, New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia and the United States of America. I have also been Invited to judge Terrier Specialties in South Africa and Ireland in 2024

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 4 and under 6 months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition except Best Baby Puppy In Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs from six to twelve months of age on the day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under the rules and regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show. Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)
